


This edition is the final issue of this publication. Beginning with 1994 data, only preliminary totals (Catalogue Number 3203.2) will be published. The age by sex data will continue to be available on request, either in hardcopy or on diskette. Subscribers to Catalogue Numbers 3203.2 and 3207.2 will be notified of the details when they have been finalised.

MAIN FEATURES

POPULATION AT 30 JUNE 1993

- The estimated resident population (ERP) in Victoria was 4,464,500.
- The population (ERP) for the Melbourne Statistical Division (MSD) was 3,189,200.
- The number of children (aged under 15 years) was 942,500 which represented 21.1 per cent of Victoria's population. Within the MSD, the highest concentrations of children were found in the Shires of Melton (29.7 per cent), Bulla (29.5 per cent) and Cranbourne (28.5 per cent). The Cities of Prahran (8.6 per cent), St Kilda (9.9 per cent), and South Melbourne (10.7 per cent) had the lowest proportions. Outside the MSD, the highest proportions of children were located in the Shires of Huntly Part A (30.3 per cent), Grenville Part A (30.1 per cent), and Romsey (29.8 per cent).
- The number of older persons (65 years and over) was 532,800 which represented 11.9 per cent of Victoria's population. Within the MSD, the highest concentrations of older persons were found in the Shire of Flinders (27.1 per cent) and the Cities of Brighton (20.3 per cent), Caulfield (18.9 per cent) and Sandringham (18.2 per cent). The Shires of Melton (4.0 per cent), Bulla (4.2 per cent), the City of Werribee (4.6 per cent) and the Shire of Cranbourne (5.1 per cent) had the lowest proportions. Outside the MSD, the highest concentrations of older persons were located in the Borough of Queenscliffe (29.9 per cent), the Shires of Phillip Island (24.9 per cent) and Bairnsdale Part A (23.2 per cent) and the Borough of Port Fairy (22.5 per cent) while the lowest proportions were located in the Shires of Traralgon Part B (3.5 per cent), Grenville Part A (4.1 per cent), Traralgon Part A (4.4 per cent) and Strathfieldsaye Part B (5.2 per cent).

MELBOURNE STATISTICAL DIVISION AND REST OF VICTORIA**




COMPARISONS WITH 1983 AND 1988

- The population (ERP) of Victoria increased by 201,900 (4.7 per cent) since 1988 and by 426,900 (10.6 per cent) since 1983.
- The population (ERP) of the MSD increased by 145,600 (4.8 per cent) since 1988 and by 299,100 (10.3 per cent) since 1983.
- The number of children (aged under 15 years) in Victoria increased by 16,200 (1.7 per cent) since 1988 but decreased by 24,100 (2.5 per cent) since 1983.
- The number of older persons (65 years and over) in Victoria increased by 62,500 (13.3 per cent) since 1988 and by 122,500 (29.9 per cent) since 1983.


PERCENTAGE OF CHILDREN IN STATISTICAL DIVISIONS

MELBOURNE STATISTICAL DIVISION**



EXPLANATORY NOTES

Introduction

1. This publication contains preliminary estimated resident population by age and sex of Statistical Local Areas (SLAs) and broader Statistical Areas of Victoria at 30 June 1993. The total population estimates of SLAs differ from those in catalogue 3203.2 as the 1992 State estimate has now been finalised. Final 1993 data, which is expected to change only very slightly, will be issued on floppy disk but not on hard copy.

2. The estimated resident population is compiled according to the place of usual residence of the population.

Methodology

3. The total population of each SLA is based on results of the 1991 population census and calculated for intercensal years by a linear regression model. The model uses independent indicators of population change such as occupied dwellings, medicare enrolments, births, deaths and school enrolments.

4. The age and sex estimates were obtained using the demographic cohort component method. Estimates for 1993 were updated from 1992 using SLA population estimates by age and sex at 30 June 1992, recorded births and deaths during the year 1992-93 and the total population estimates at 30 June 1993. The total population growth for an SLA during 1992-93 was split into natural increase and net migration components, the latter being the difference between total growth and natural increase during 1992-93. Age-sex estimates of natural increase were obtained from vital registrations (i.e. births and deaths), and those for net migration were derived as follows:

(i) the net migration component was subdivided into internal arrivals and departures and overseas arrivals and departures, and proportionate age-sex distributions were allocated to each of these subdivisions for each SLA;

(ii) SLA specific migration profiles (the proportionate age-sex distributions) for inter-SLA arrival, inter-SLA departure and overseas arrival to each SLA were obtained from the 1986 Census data on usual residence one year prior to the census date; and

(iii) age-sex migration profiles for overseas departures were based on an average of overseas departures from the State/Territory which incorporated the SLA during the period January 1985 to December 1987 as obtained from passenger cards.

Reliability

5. Estimates for each age and sex category are shown to the nearest unit without rounding; **accuracy to this level is not claimed and should not be assumed**. Estimates in catalogue 3203.2 are published to the nearest fifty persons in the Melbourne Statistical Division, and the nearest ten persons in the rest of

Victoria. Rounding is not done in this publication however because rounding of small cells could result in substantial year to year fluctuations owing to the rounding process rather than the actual population change.

Australian Standard Geographical Classification

6. The geographic areas used in this publication are defined in the *Australian Standard Geographical Classification (ASGC) Edition 2.1* (1216.0). Readers are urged to familiarise themselves with this publication for a full description of the boundary changes.

Changes to Statistical Boundaries

7. The boundaries of SLAs used in determining the population were those in existence at 30 June 1993. The population estimates for previous years have been adjusted where appropriate so that they reflect the population changes for each area had the June 1993 boundaries existed then.

8. A list of boundary changes in SLAs which occurred between 1 July 1991 and 30 June 1993 are shown in Table 2 on page 53.

9. The Victorian Government proclaimed a City of Greater Geelong on 18 May 1993, which amalgamated Geelong (C), Geelong West (C), Corio (S), South Barwon (C), Newtown (C) and Bellarine (RC). It is understood that amalgamated councils will eventually be abolished, and a new Greater Geelong council established. This affected 8 LGAs and 11 SLAs. Pending final ASGC adaptation to the City of Greater Geelong boundary amalgamation, the following interim SLA changes were used to accommodate LGA splitting of Barrabool (S) and Bannockburn (S):

all of Bannockburn (S) Part A to Corio (S) Part A;
all of Barrabool (S) Part A to South Barwon (C) Part A; and
part of Barrabool (S) Part B to South Barwon (C) Parts A and B.

Consequently, Barrabool (S) Part B and Bannockburn (S) Part B have been renamed Barrabool (S) and Bannockburn (S) respectively while awaiting ASGC review of the new City of Greater Geelong boundaries.

Data on Floppy Disk

10. Estimated resident population classified by age and sex for 30 June 1986, 1987, 1988, 1989, 1990, 1991, 1992 and 1993 is available on floppy disk (3208.2) - a separate disk for each year and priced at \$100 each. Population Projection

11. The ABS compiles and publishes population projections for Australia, States and Territories (3222.0).
12. The ABS as part of its Statistical Consultancy Service can prepare ad hoc population projections at the SLA or higher level. The projections are based on the latest published Estimated Resident Population by age and sex. Clients can supply their own assumptions of migration, fertility and mortality or approve the use of ABS derived assumptions.
