


## MAIN FEATURES

At 30 June 1993, the estimated resident population of Australia aged 15 years and over (13,830,300) comprised 4,171,100 never married, 7,994,600 currently married, 861,200 widowed and 803,400 divorced persons.

During 1992-93 the divorced population showed the highest percentage increase, rising by 5.3 per cent (40,100), followed by the never married population aged 15 years and over (up 1.6% or 64,100), the widowed population (up 0.8% or 7,200) and the currently married population (up 0.6% or 44,200). In the same period the overall population aged 15 years and over increased by 155,600 (1.1%).

### INCREASE IN POPULATION BY MARITAL STATUS DURING 1992-93, AUSTRALIA



For ages 65 and over improvements in mortality over time have resulted in reductions in the proportions widowed and corresponding increases in the proportions married (see Table). The most significant change has occurred in the age group 85 years and over where the percentage of widowed males decreased from 50.4 to 37.3 while for females there was a decrease from 81.2 to 72.5.



The proportions of the male population who were currently married in 1993 are smaller than the proportions in 1981 up to age group 65 to 69 years. These lower proportions reflect the changing marriage patterns, caused by later marriages, the increasing number of divorces and people choosing not to get married. The highest percentage of the population who were divorced in 1993 was 9.5 per cent (in age group 45 to 49 years), compared to 1981 where the highest percentage was 5.4 per cent for age group 40 to 44 years. In 1981 the highest percentage married (85.7%) was reached in age group 40 to 44 years, while in 1993 the largest percentage (82.1%) was lower and occurred in the age group 55 to 59 years. The higher proportion of males who remain married in 1993 at ages 70 and over is the result of lower death rates among both married males and females. The percentage of the male population who were currently married at ages 85 years and over increased from 40.7 per cent in 1981 to 52.0 per cent in 1993.

Among females the patterns are similar. The percentages for those currently married in 1993 were lower than in 1981 up to age group 55 to 59 years. The highest percentage (86.4%) occurred in age group 35 to 39 years in 1981 while in 1993 the highest percentage (80.1%) was in the age group 45 to 49 years. The percentage of female population who were divorced reached a maximum of 11.7 per cent (in age group 45 to 49 years) in 1993 whereas the largest percentage in 1981 was only 6.8 per cent (in age group 40 to 44 years). The percentage of females at ages 85 and older who are currently married has risen from 6.5 per cent in 1981 to 14.6 per cent in 1993.

### MARRIED FEMALES, AUSTRALIA



## EXPLANATORY NOTES

### **Introduction**

This publication contains preliminary estimates of the resident population of Australia by marital status, age and sex as at 30 June 1992 and 1993.

### **Revisions**

2. The 1987, 1988, 1989, 1990 and 1991 estimates have been revised in the light of results from the 1991 Census of Population and Housing. These estimates are now final. The 1992 and 1993 estimates are preliminary and will be revised when more accurate data for deaths, marriages, divorces and category jumping by marital status become available.

3. The estimated resident population is the official population estimates series compiled according to the place of usual residence of the population.

4. An explanation of the conceptual basis for population estimates is given in the ABS technical paper, *Methods and Procedures in the Compilation of Estimated Resident Population 1981 and in the Construction of the 1971-81 Time Series* (3102.0), issued on 11 March 1983. In this publication, compilation of the estimated resident population has been extended to classify the population by marital status.

### **Method of estimation**

5. For a description of the method used in estimating the resident population by marital status see the issue in this series (3220.0) for June 1976, 1981 to 1987, released on 15 July 1988.

6. The estimates as at 30 June 1993 were obtained by advancing 30 June 1992 estimates to the next age and adjusting for natural increase and estimated net overseas migration by marital status, age and sex which were recorded in the financial year 1992-93. Adjustments are also made to account for changes in marital status during the financial year due to marriages, divorces and widowhood/widowerhood.

7. Persons aged 14 years and under were coded to 'never married' in the 1991 and previous censuses. This convention has been followed in this publication.

### **Marital status**

8. Two separate concepts are measured by the ABS. These are Registered Marital Status and Social Marital Status. They are different personal characteristics and are independent variables with separate classifications. Marital Status in this publication relates to Registered Marital Status.

### **Reliability of estimates**

9. All estimates of age distributions are shown in units without being rounded. However, accuracy down to the last unit is not claimed and should not be assumed. This is particularly the case for single year age data.

10. Single year age estimates are not shown for persons aged 85 years or older. The reliability of age estimates decreases as older ages are reached. Estimates for each age up to 99 have, however, been calculated and are available on request.
