EXPLANATORY NOTES

This bulletin shows statistics of schools in Australia for 1963 with comparative figures for earlier years. In Section I, figures are given of the number of schools, teachers and pupils, including ages and grades of pupils. Section II contains statistics of pupils by grade combined with age. A table showing grades of pupils in government schools, and in non-government schools by denominations appears in this bulletin for the first time.

2. The statistics relate to schools providing education according to the primary and secondary school curricula of the State Education Departments, whether provided in government or non-government schools. Junior technical schools, correspondence schools and schools in institutional homes, hospitals and similar establishments are included. Institutions providing only pre-school education, senior technical and agricultural colleges, evening schools, continuation classes and institutions such as business colleges and coaching establishments are, as a rule, excluded. However, it has not been possible so far to apply these definitions strictly in all States. For instance, schools for aboriginal children are excluded in Queensland and the Northern Territory. Tasmanian pre-schools are included, but Western Australian kindergartens are excluded. Adults enrolled at correspondence schools are excluded in Tasmania but included in Queensland.

3. "School Censuses" are conducted annually in all States and the internal Territories of Australia at or about the beginning of August. The numbers of pupils refer to the position at the school census date. The numbers of schools and teachers refer to the position at dates which vary from State to State and in some instances from year to year.

4. It has not been possible to present all figures on a uniform basis between States but continuity of the figures for any one State over the period of years shown has been maintained as far as possible. Investigations aimed at improving the scope and comparability of the statistics are being continued. While there are still differences in the bases on which schools and pupils are counted, they are small compared with the differences existing because of the varying methods of counting teachers, particularly part-time staff, the inclusion or exclusion of special purpose teachers, and the classification of teachers who, besides primary and secondary teaching are also engaged on other duties. For this reason, inter-State and inter-system comparisons of the number of pupils per teacher should not be made on the basis of the unadjusted figures presented in this bulletin.

5. Comparisons between States and between government and non-government schools are also affected by differences in the school systems, especially regarding ages of commencing full-time education, cessation of compulsory education, and transfer from secondary to vocational education.

6. The classification by grade of the figures in table 11 and the age/grade tables presented in Section II of this bulletin are not comparable between States, nor entirely between government and non-government schools in any one State, and this is one reason why the separate tables have not been aggregated into an Australian table. The grading of pupils differs for the various school-systems in Australia, because of the differences in curricula set by education departments. In addition, the methods of allocating classes to grades, particularly classes for special or ungraded pupils, vary from State to State, and there are also differences in the administrative methods of aggregating grades of a more or less similar nature. While the tables have been slightly rearranged from the data provided by the education departments and other sources (for instance, separate tables for primary and secondary schools in some States were combined into one table), they represent essentially the system of grading adopted in each different State.

7. Reference should be made to the annual reports of the State Education Departments and to the publications of the Deputy Commonwealth Statistician in each State for detailed schools statistics for each State. For a general description of the Australian school systems, see the latest issue of the Commonwealth Yearbook, (No. 49 - 1963, also available in a separate Yearbook part - Part VII Education, Justice, Health, Welfare Services) and for comparative statements see the various Bulletins issued by the Commonwealth Office of Education.
