EXPLANATORY NOTES

This bulletin shows statistics of schools in Australia for 1964 with comparative figures for earlier years. A summary statement of the number of pupils according to grades was issued on 8th March, 1965 (see Social Statistics, No. 27, School Enrolments, 1964) and is reproduced in Table 14 of this bulletin.

2. In Section I, figures are given of the number of schools, teachers and pupils, including ages and grades of pupils. Table 11, showing the ages of pupils in the various categories of schools, appears for the first time in this series of bulletins. Section II contains statistics of pupils by grade combined with age.

3. The numbers of schools shown in Tables 1 and 5 include the schools providing education according to the primary, secondary (or both) school curricula of the State Education Departments, whether provided in government or non-government schools. Junior technical schools, correspondence schools and schools in institutional homes, hospitals, missions and similar establishments are included. Institutions providing only pre-school education, senior technical and agricultural colleges, evening schools, continuation classes and institutions such as business colleges and coaching establishments are, as a rule, excluded.

4. For the first time in this series of bulletins, "Special schools" are shown separately. A "Special school" is a school specifically intended for the instruction of pupils who are physically or mentally handicapped, socially maladjusted, or who are in similar other categories not normally taught in ordinary schools, and who, but for these handicaps, would be receiving full-time education at ordinary schools. Schools specifically set up for the education of Aboriginal boys and girls requiring other than ordinary schooling are included as Special schools.

5. Once a school is included in the collection, all pupils in that school are included, even though some of them may not receive primary or secondary education. For instance, all pupils in Tasmanian pre-schools are included, although only a portion of them follow the primary curriculum, but all pupils in kindergartens are excluded in that and all other States. However, adult correspondence pupils are excluded as far as possible. The figures in Table 2 show the total number of pupils in the various categories for schools set out in Table 1. It should be noted that pupils attending Special schools may follow the normal curricula and pupils at ordinary schools may be in special classes, etc. and follow special curricula to suit their needs. Thus the figures provided in Table 2 give no indication of the number of boys and girls requiring or receiving special education. The differences in the organisation of Special, Aboriginal and correspondence education in the various States should be borne in mind in this connection.

6. Tables 8 to 13, showing ages of pupils, and Tables 15 to 38, showing ages combined with grades, exclude a small number of pupils for which age information is not available. The grade information provided in Tables 14 and 15 to 38 is not comparable between States and this is one reason why the State figures have not been aggregated into Australian tables. The grading of pupils differs for the various school systems in Australia because of the difference in curricula set by Education Departments. In addition, the methods of allocating classes to grades, particularly classes for special or ungraded pupils, vary from State to State and there are also differences in the administrative methods of aggregating grades of a more or less similar nature. There is some difference in the grading adopted, within each State, for government schools and various non-government schools, but these differences are likely to be small. While the tables have been slightly rearranged from the data provided by the Education Departments and other sources (for instance, separate tables for primary and secondary schools in some States were combined into one table), they represent essentially the system of grading adopted in each different State.

7. "School Censuses" are conducted annually in all States and the internal Territories of Australia at or about the beginning of August. The numbers of pupils refer to enrolments at the school census date. The numbers of schools and teachers refer to the position at dates which vary from State to State and in some instances from year to year.

8. The presentation of teacher statistics in this bulletin has been changed from that in issues for previous years, in order to show more clearly the bases used for counting part-time teachers. For New South Wales and the Australian Capital Territory government schools, part-time teachers are counted as full-time equivalents (i.e., as fractions based on the proportion of their pay to the normal full-time salary in each teaching grade) and

figures for part-time teaching separate from full-time teachers are not available. In Western Australia also, part-time teaching has been shown in this way since 1962 for government schools, but separate figures for full-time and part-time teaching are compiled. The bases on which part-time teaching figures are available for Western Australian non-government schools varies from year to year. All other figures refer to the number of full-time and part-time teachers. The footnotes to Tables 3, 4 and 7 indicate as far as possible the varying bases on which teacher figures have been compiled. Apart from the differences so noted, there are differences arising from the inclusion or exclusion of special purpose, casual and trainee teachers, the classification of teachers who, besides primary and secondary teaching, are also engaged on other duties, and the inclusion or exclusion of teachers who were employed for various periods during a year. Many differences of this nature remain between States and between systems, and the effect of these differences on the figures shown cannot be gauged. For these reasons, comparisons of teacher figures between States and systems and over years should be made with great caution. Comparisons of the number of pupils per teacher should not be made on the basis of the figures presented in this bulletin.

9. Differences in the school systems, especially regarding ages of commencing full-time education, cessation of compulsory education and transfer from secondary to vocational education, also have a major bearing on the figures presented in this bulletin and should be kept in mind in inter-State and inter-system comparisons.

10. Reference should be made, as appropriate, to the annual reports of the State Education Departments and to the publications of the Deputy Commonwealth Statistician in each State for detailed schools statistics for each State. For a general description of the Australian school systems, see the latest issue of the Commonwealth Yearbook, (No. 50 - 1964, also available in a separate Yearbook part - Part VII, Education, Justice, Health, Welfare Services) and for comparative statements see the various Bulletins issued by the Commonwealth Office of Education.
