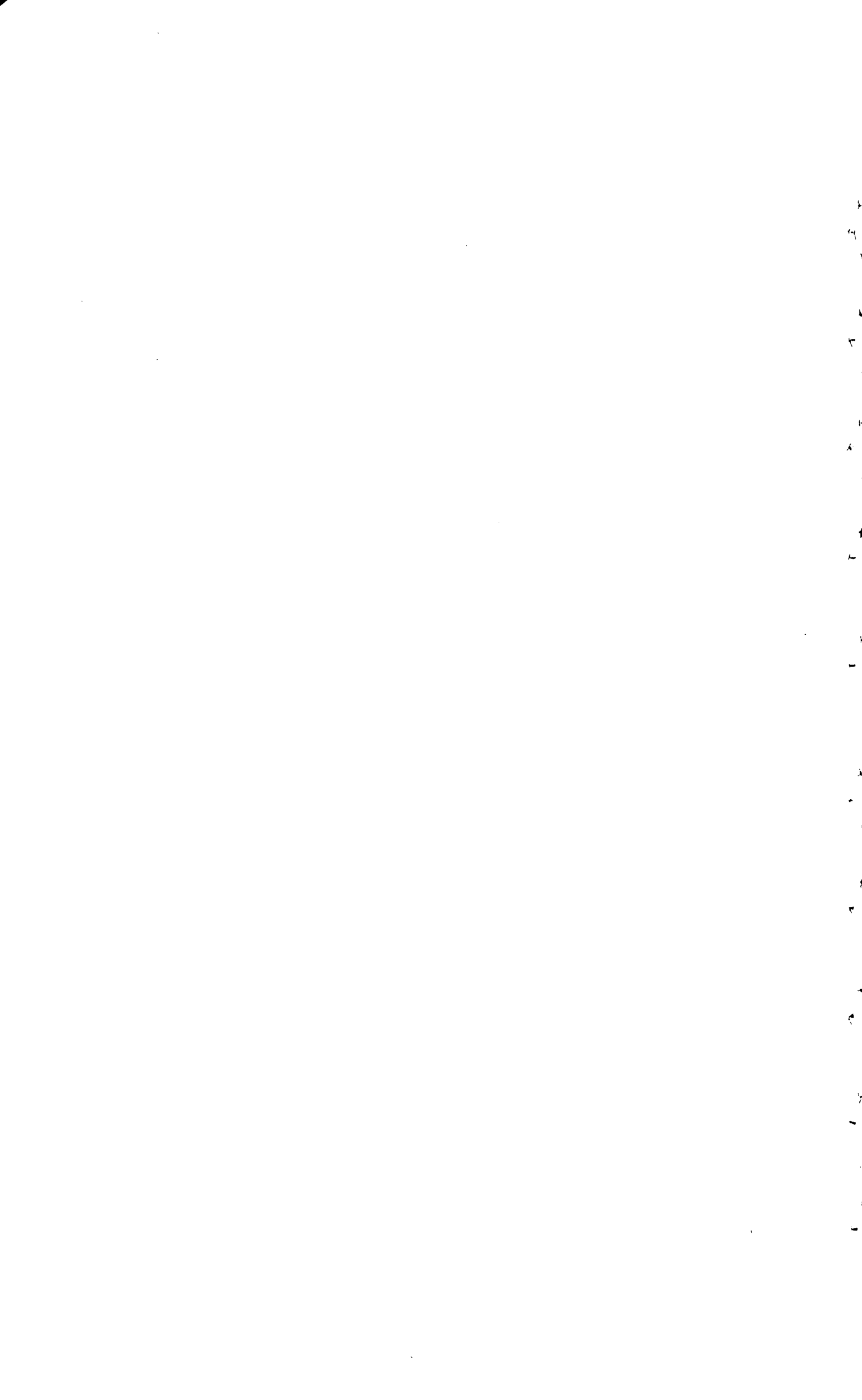

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EXPLANATORY NOTES

This Bulletin contains preliminary summary figures of university students, university staff and university finance. The statistics are derived from information supplied by the universities and reflect the situation at the dates or for the periods indicated below. They will be superseded by bulletins showing final and more detailed figures to be published in due course.

2. The student statistics in Tables 1 to 5 refer to 1966 enrolments up to the end of March. The figures are of enrolments for courses, i.e., a student enrolled for more than one course is counted more than once. The universities were also asked to provide estimates of likely enrolments during the remainder of the academic year. Their replies are summarized below :-

3. While the full-time staff statistics shown in Tables 6 to 8 refer to recognized and filled positions as at the 31st March, 1966, the part-time staff statistics shown in Tables 6 and 9 are estimates by the universities of part-time work over the whole of 1966. The reliability of the part-time staff estimates for the whole year may vary according to circumstances from university to university. Being based on the same concepts and expressed in the same units as the part-time staff figures issued in the detailed bulletins for 1961 and subsequent years, the 1966 estimates of part-time staff are directly comparable with the figures for 1961 onwards.

4. The figures of university income and expenditure appearing in Table 10 refer to the year 1965. They are shown in decimal currency (£1 = 2 dollars).

5. The statistics in this bulletin are on the same bases as those published in the bulletins "University Statistics" for 1961 to 1965. This bulletin should be read in conjunction with these detailed bulletins which contain full definitions of the concepts used.

6. Care should be exercised in making comparisons of figures from year to year and between universities, as the figures are affected by differences and changes in the composition of staff and students; for instance, in the proportions of full-time and part-time teaching and in the proportions of full-time and part-time students.

7. Figures relating to Macquarie University, La Trobe University and the Flinders University of South Australia (known in 1965 as the University of Adelaide at Bedford Park) are published in this bulletin for the first time. Staff and finance figures only are shown for La Trobe University, as enrolments will not be accepted until 1967. A small number of higher degree students were accepted for enrolment at Macquarie University this year.
