### MAIN FEATURES

- . The apparent consumption of tea during the year ended 30 June 1979 was 1.68 kg per capita, which is an increase of 8 per cent on the year ended 30 June 1978.
- . The apparent consumption of coffee during the year ended 30 June 1979 was 1.68 kg per capita, an increase of 36 per cent on the year ended 30 June 1978.

#### EXPLANATORY NOTES

This publication contains particulars of the apparent consumption of tea and coffee in terms of the quantities available for consumption, together with additional details of imports of tea and coffee.

2. In general, consumption data have been obtained by deducting quantities of these commodities exported from imports cleared for home consumption. An adjustment has been made for changes in stocks held by importers and wholesalers of tea and coffee products at 30 June each year. No account has been taken of

changes in stocks held by retailers and other distributing agencies.
