

MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATIONS, TASMANIA, APRIL 1994

MAIN FEATURES

- There were 806 new motor vehicles (excluding motorcycles) registered during April 1994, 16.6 per cent less than in March 1994 (967).
- Five makes (Toyota, Ford, Mitsubishi, Holden and Nissan) accounted for 78.7 per cent of all new motor vehicle registrations (excluding motorcycles) in April 1994.
- Registrations of new motor vehicles (excluding motorcycles) during the 12 months ended April 1994 (12 443) were 0.1 per cent less than the 12 months ended April 1993 (12 454).



EXPLANATORY NOTES

- 1. This publication contains details for Tasmania of new motor vehicles registered. The figures comprise all privately-owned vehicles and all vehicles owned by the State or Commonwealth Governments, except those belonging to the defence services.
- 2. The statistics in this publication are based, from November 1990 onwards, on new processing procedures using the new Vehicle Identification Number (VIN) adopted by the motor vehicle authorities. The VIN system allows more accurate classification of vehicles. As a result, data processed on this system are not strictly comparable with those processed on the old system, for some States. Both the old and the new series were compiled for an overlapping period from December 1990 to June 1991. Detailed statistics compiled on both bases are available on request.
- 3. Tractors, mobile plant and equipment, caravans and other trailers are excluded from all tables except Table 8.
- 4. Passenger vehicles. Vehicles constructed primarily for the carriage of less than 10 passengers (including the driver). Included are cars, station wagons, 4WD passenger vehicles and forward control passenger vehicles.
- 5. Light commercial vehicles. Vehicles constructed primarily for the carriage of goods and do not exceed 3.5 tonnes gross vehicles mass (GVM). Included are utilities, panel vans, cab-chassis and forward control vehicles (whether 4WD or not).

- 6. Rigid Trucks. Vehicles constructed primarily for load carrying with a gross vehicles mass (GVM) exceeding 3.5 tonnes. Included are normal rigid trucks with a tow bar, draw bar or other non-articulated coupling on the rear for use with a trailer or dolly.
- 7 Articulated Trucks. Vehicles constructed primarily for load carrying consisting of a prime mover having no significant load carrying area but with a turn table device which can be linked to a trailer. With or without a trailer the gross combination mass (GCM) will exceed 3.5 tonnes.
- 8 Non-freight Carrying Trucks. Includes specialist vehicles such as ambulances or mobile cranes or vehicles fitted with special purpose equipment and having no goods carrying capacity.
- 9 Buses. Includes all passenger vehicles having more than nine seats, including the driver.
- 10. Tasmanian monthly data are published on a preliminary basis. Due to improved collection methods using VIN and other revision of data there may be some slight disagreement between yearly figures and aggregated monthly data.
- 11. Symbols and other usages.
