- Changes in the ASIC treatment of certain activities, which may be identified from Table 3
  "Detailed Differences Between Classes". These detailed differences at the ASIC Class level may be aggregated to the Subdivision or Division level as required.

- (b) The ASIC Class covering iron ore pelletising is included in Subdivision 11, Division B Mining in the 1978 ed. ASIC as Class 1112. This Class was previously included in Subdivision 29, Division C Manufacturing in the 1969 ed. ASIC as Class 2911.
- (c) A new Class 4248 Earthmoving and Dredging has been created in Subdivision 42 in the 1978 ed. ASIC. The activities included in this new Class were previously included in Class 4120 in Subdivision 41 of the 1969 ed. ASIC.
- (d) A new Class 6162 Holding Companies n.e.c. has been created in Subdivision 61, Division I Finance, Property and Business Services. Creation of this Class represents a change of a conceptual nature in the ASIC. Direct alignment with any 1969 ed. ASIC Class or set of Classes is therefore not possible.
- (e) A new Class 6388 Contract Packing Services n.e.c. has been created in Subdivision 63, Division I Finance, Property and Business Services in the 1978 ed. ASIC. The activities included in this new Class were previously included in the 1969 ed. ASIC in Classes in Subdivisions 23 to 34, Division C Manufacturing, according to the type of good being packed.
- (f) A separate Division (Division M), incorporating Subdivision 99 Non-Classifiable Economic Units has been created in the 1978 ed. ASIC. Subdivision 99 was included in Division L in the 1969 ed. ASIC.
