TABLE 3 : DETAILED DIFFERENCES BETWEEN CLASSES

EXPLANATORY NOTES:

This table identifies the differences between the industry classes of the 1978 edition of the ASIC and the broadly equivalent classes of the 1969 edition. The differences identified in Table 3 comprise those primary activities whose ASIC treatment according to the 1978 edition of the Classification differ from the treatment given in the 1969 edition of the Classification.

The table portrays the differences between the two editions of the Classification in terms of the following relationship:

$$1978 \text{ ED. ASIC CLASS} = 1969 \text{ ED. ASIC CLASS} + \text{OR} - \text{PRIMARY ACTIVITIES LISTED}$$

This means that a 1978 ASIC Class is portrayed as consisting of establishments mainly engaged in the same primary activities as those listed against the equivalent 1969 ASIC Class with the addition or exception of the specified primary activities. (It should be noted that in some cases the primary activity descriptions included in the table are not actual descriptions as used in either edition of the ASIC. This occurs, for example, where only part of a previously specified primary activity has been affected by a change in ASIC treatment.)

While no quantitative measures are provided on the changes identified in Table 3 it is possible, nevertheless, to assess the kinds of establishments that would be classified to a different industry on the basis of the changes in the definitional content of an ASIC Class. eg Table 3 indicates that 1978 ed. ASIC Class 3482 is equivalent to 1969 ed. ASIC Class 3442 except that establishments mainly engaged in manufacturing silver or gold plated cutlery (which would previously have been classified to 1969 ed. ASIC Class 3442) would now be classified to 1978 ed. ASIC Class 3161.

The detailed differences between ASIC Classes identified in Table 3 may be aggregated to determine the differences at the broader levels of the Classification (ie at the ASIC Group, Subdivision and Division levels).

The reference columns in this table provide information on the ASIC treatment of a listed primary activity in terms of both editions of the ASIC.

The comments column includes, where appropriate, summary statements and other general comments which highlight the main definitional differences between two broadly aligned classes.

Changes to primary activities relating to Installation, Repair and Maintenance, Packing, Leasing and Hiring are only listed in Table 3 where these activities are specifically included in the list of primary activities of ASIC Classes in either edition of the Classification. Consequently, when assessing the overall difference between two broadly equivalent ASIC Classes in which these activities are not listed, reference should be made to the detailed explanation of their treatment as set out in Chapter 5 Volume 1 of both editions of the Classification.

Note that Table 3 is presented in double-page format and that primary activities, representing the differences between a particular 1978 and 1969 ed. ASIC Class, are listed as follows: "-" (minus) entries first (in alphabetical order) followed by "+" (plus) entries (in alphabetical order).

Footnotes relating to Table 3 are included at the end of the table.

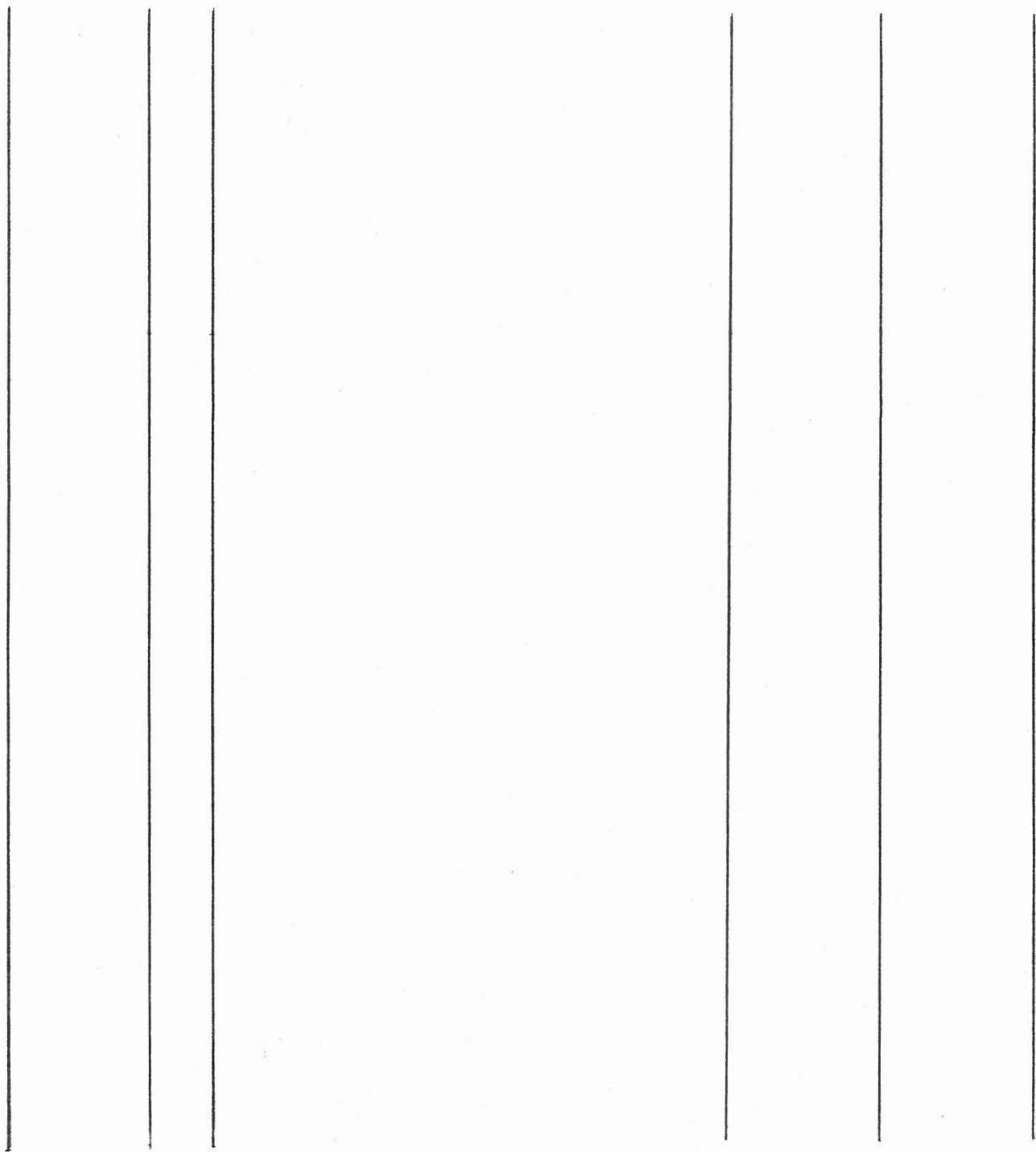

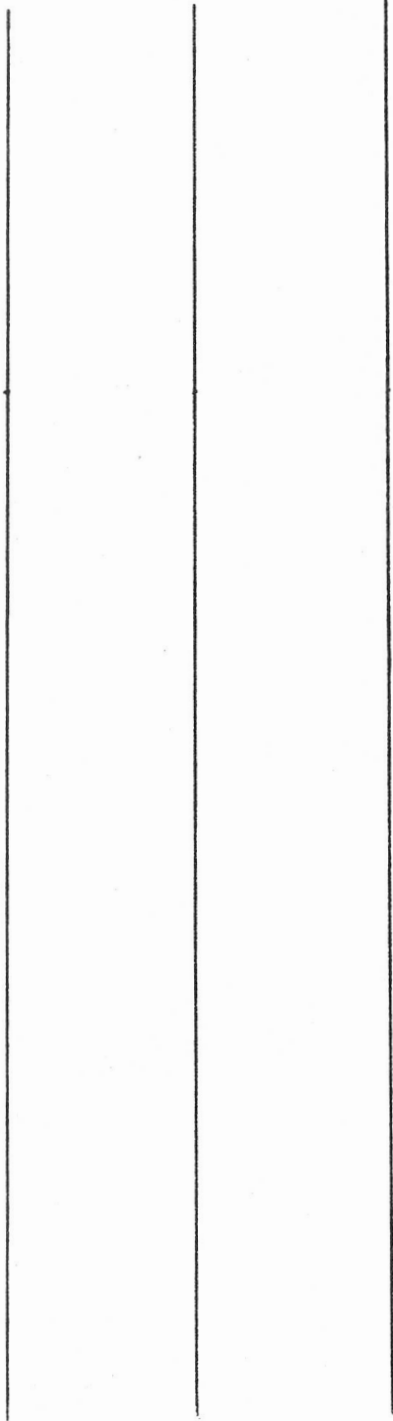
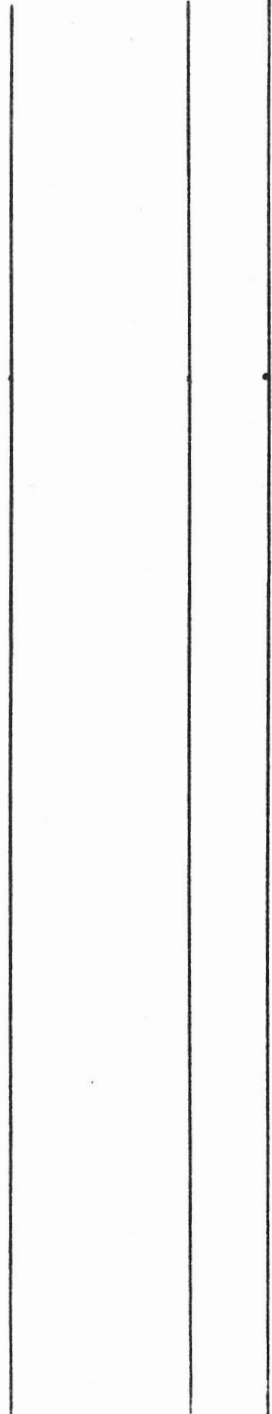

- (a) The presentation of the 'broad alignment' between the 1978 and 1969 ed. ASIC Classes in Table 3 may differ in some instances from that shown in Table 2. This is because Table 3 has been designed to show the changes relating to each individual 1978 ed. ASIC Class in terms of primary activities. As a consequence, 1969 ed. ASIC Class codes may be repeated in the broad alignment column in Table 3.
- (b) For ASIC Subdivision 01 Agriculture, the alignment in Table 3 is between classes in the 1978 ed. ASIC and classes in the 1974 Interim Revised Subdivision 01 (not the 1969 ed. ASIC).
- (c) Activities designated "+" are those which are regarded as being primary to the 1978 ed. ASIC Class but not primary to the equivalent 1969 ed. ASIC Class. Activities designated "-" are those which are regarded as being primary to the 1969 ed. ASIC Class but not primary to the equivalent 1978 ed. ASIC Class. (For ASIC Subdivision 01 Agriculture, the 1974 Interim Revised version applies in lieu of the 1969 ed. ASIC - see note (b) above).
- (d) The activity listed has been specified in the ASIC for the first time. No change in ASIC treatment is involved i.e. it has been determined that the activity listed would previously have been primary to the 1969 ed. ASIC Class indicated.
- (e) Activity description no longer specified in the ASIC. The reasons for deleting certain activity descriptions include; ambiguity in description; space constraints; relative insignificance of the activity; description redundant; or, ASIC treatment unresolved.
- (f) In the 1969 ed. ASIC, classes in Subdivisions 23 to 34 in Division C Manufacturing included contract packing services for a wide range of goods. The contract packing of a particular good in the 1969 ed. ASIC was regarded as being primary to the class which covered the manufacture of that good. In the 1978 ed. ASIC a separate class (Class 6388) has been created to cover the contract packing of goods whose manufacture is designated primary to classes in Subdivisions 23 to 34 inclusive.
- (g) Iron ore pelletising (1969 ed. ASIC Class 2911) is included in the 1978 ed. ASIC in Division B Mining as Class 1112.
