NOTES

ABOUT THIS PUBLICATION

This publication contains estimates of the resident populations of Statistical Local Areas (SLAs) and Local Government Areas (LGAs) of Tasmania by age and sex as at 30 June 1999. Also included are estimated resident populations for 1998.

Information on the methodology used to estimate resident population in Tasmania (and in the LGAs and SLAs) is contained in the Explanatory Notes at the back of this publication.

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SUMMARY OF FINDINGS

TOTAL POPULATION

The estimated resident population of Tasmania as at 30 June 1999 was 470,261, a decrease of 1,439 since June 1998. The population has been in decline since 30 September 1996 when the population reached its highest level of 474,514. The growth rate for 1998–99 was –0.31%, compared with a growth rate of –0.34% for 1997–98.

Five statistical subdivisions lost population for 1998–99. The decreases were Greater Hobart (730 or 0.4%), Greater Launceston (153 or 0.2%), Burnie–Devonport (427 or 0.5%), North Eastern (8 or 0.1%) and Lyell (240 or 4.0%). Increases were experienced in Southern (83 or 0.2%) and North Western Rural (36 or 0.1%). Central North was unchanged.

MEDIAN AGE

The median age of the estimated resident population of Tasmania as at 30 June 1999 was 36.1, an increase of 0.5 years on the 35.6 for 30 June 1998, and 1.2 years higher than the Australian median age of 34.9 years. The median age for Tasmanian males increased from 34.8 at 30 June 1998 to 35.3 at 30 June 1999. The equivalent figures for Tasmanian females were 36.3 in 1998 and 36.8 in 1999.

The highest median age among the subdivisions was in North Eastern (38.7 years), followed by Southern (37.1 years) and Central North (36.9 years). The lowest median ages were recorded by Lyell (31.8 years) and North Western Rural (34.4 years).

The local government areas with the highest median ages were Glamorgan/Spring Bay (41.6 years), Break O'Day (40.8 years), Tasman (40.2 years), Flinders (40.0 years) and Latrobe (38.6 years). Local government areas with the lowest median ages included Brighton (28.4 years), West Coast (31.8 years), Circular Head (32.7 years) and Sorell (34.2 years).

Local government areas with the highest median ages for males were Tasman (41.8 years), Break O'Day (41.4 years), Glamorgan/Spring Bay (41.3 years) and Flinders (41.2 years). Local government areas with the lowest median ages for males included Brighton (28.3 years), West Coast (31.6 years), Circular Head (32.5 years), Launceston (34.0 years) and Sorell (34.0 years).

Local government areas with the highest median ages for females were Glamorgan/Spring Bay (41.8 years), Break O'Day (40.0 years), Clarence (38.7 years), Dorset (38.3 years) and Tasman (38.3 years). Local government areas with the lowest median ages for females included Brighton (28.6 years), West Coast (32.0 years), Circular Head (33.0 years) and George Town (34.2 years).

AGE STRUCTURE

Population aged 0–14 years

The population aged 0–14 years was estimated to be 100,169 persons, or 21.3% of the population of Tasmania at 30 June 1999, compared with 105,820 persons (23.2%) in 1989.

The subdivision with the highest proportion of its population in the 0–14 age group was Lyell (25.9%), followed by North Western Rural (24.5%) and Southern (22.9%). Greater Hobart (20.5%) and Greater Launceston (20.7%) had the lowest proportions.

The local government areas with the highest proportion of children aged 0–14 years were Brighton (29.5%), West Coast (25.9%), Sorell (25.6%) and Circular Head (24.7%). The local government areas of Hobart (15.7%), Launceston (19.3%), Glenorchy (19.8%) and Glamorgan/Spring Bay (19.8%) were estimated to have had the lowest proportions of children aged 0–14 years.

Population aged 15–64 years

The population aged 15–64 years was estimated to be 307,032 persons, or 65.3% of the population of Tasmania at 30 June 1999, compared with 296,761 persons (65.2%) in 1989.

The subdivision of Lyell had the highest proportion of its population in the 15–64 age group (66.7%), followed by Greater Hobart (66.0%), North Western Rural (65.9%) and Central North (65.8%). North Eastern had the lowest proportion (62.2%).

The local government areas with the highest proportion aged 15–64 years were Hobart (70.0%), West Coast (66.7%), Kentish (66.1%) and Derwent Valley (65.8%). The local government areas of Dorset (61.5%), Break O'Day (62.7%) and Waratah/Wynyard (63.4%) were estimated to have the lowest proportions of their populations aged 15–64 years.

Population aged 65 years and over

The 65-years-and-over age group was estimated to be 63,060 persons, or 13.4% of the population of Tasmania at 30 June 1999, compared with 52,677 persons (11.6%) in 1989.

Between 1998 and 1999, the number of persons aged 65 and over grew in all subdivisions.

The subdivision with the highest proportion of its population in the 65-year-and-over age group was North Eastern (15.3%), followed by Burnie–Devonport (14.7%) and Greater Launceston (14.2%). Lyell had the lowest proportion (7.5%).

Glamorgan/Spring Bay had the highest proportion of its population aged 65 years and over (17.0%) followed by Glenorchy (15.9%) and Break O'Day (15.8%). Lowest proportions were recorded by Brighton (5.1%), West Coast (7.5%), Circular Head (10.5%) and Kentish (10.6%).

SUMMARY OF FINDINGS *continued*

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Population aged 85 years and over

The population aged 85 years and over in Tasmania was estimated to be 6,483 persons, or 1.4% of the population at 30 June 1999, compared with 3,831 persons (0.8%) in 1989.

The subdivisions with the highest proportion of their population in the 85-years-and-over age group were Burnie–Devonport (1.5%) and Greater Launceston (1.5%). Lowest proportions were recorded by Lyell (0.5%) and North Western Rural (0.9%).

Hobart and Flinders had the highest proportions of their populations aged 85 years and over (2.0%) followed by Launceston (1.9%) and Central Highlands (1.8%). Lowest proportions were recorded by West Coast (0.5%), Southern Midlands (0.7%), Brighton (0.7%), Sorell (0.7%) and George Town (0.8%).

EXPLANATORY NOTES

METHODOLOGY

- 1** Australia's population statistics (since 1971) have been compiled according to the place of usual residence of the population. An explanation of the conceptual basis is given in the ABS Information Paper *Population Estimates: Concepts, Sources and Methods* (Cat. no. 3228.0) issued on 23 June 1995.
- 2** The estimated resident population of any area at a Census date is derived by adjusting the Census Count Place of Enumeration data to exclude visitors who normally reside outside the area, to include residents who were temporarily absent in other areas or overseas, and to apply a factor for census under-enumeration.
- 3** Due to the 1996 Census being held on 6 August, further adjustments were made for births, deaths and net migration for the period 30 June to 6 August 1996 to arrive at an estimated resident population at 30 June 1996.
- 4** Post-censal estimates at the National and State and Territory levels are made quarterly and are obtained by adding components of natural increase (on a usual residence basis) and net migration gain to the population at the beginning of each period.
- 5** At the National level, estimates of overseas migration are based on net permanent and long-term overseas movements as recorded on passenger cards completed by incoming and outgoing travellers for the Department of Immigration and Multicultural Affairs.
- 6** At the State and Territory level, information about internal migration is available from population censuses and from a sample survey of internal movements (conducted at more or less annual intervals to 1987 and resumed in 1991). These sources, however, do not provide the up-to-date quarterly estimates of interstate migration required for regular population estimates. The only suitable sources for this purpose are administrative records. Since June 1986, quarterly estimates of internal migration have been derived from changes of addresses advised to the Health Insurance Commission in the process of administering Medicare.
- 7** Post-censal Statistical Local Area (SLA) estimates are made annually and are produced with the assistance of local government authorities and other bodies who provide information on significant local factors which may have caused population changes in the relevant period.
- 8** Estimates for Tasmania and component areas, based on 1996 Census results, were first published in *Regional Population Growth, Australia, 1996 Census Edition, 1991–96* (Cat. no. 3218.0). This publication was released on 15 July 1997.

DATA QUALITY

- 9** The quality of estimates in this publication depends on the quality of population census results (including under-enumeration adjustments) and on the various components and indicators of population change.

10 The statistical geography used in this publication is based on the *Australian Standard Geographical Classification (ASGC), 1998* (Cat. no. 1216.0).

11 Population estimates for statistical local areas and local government areas in this publication are based on the boundaries in existence at 30 June 1999.
