#### ABOUT THE PUBLICATION

The 2002–2003 national census of private hospitals used two forms to collect data: PHE1 for private acute and psychiatric hospitals and PHE2 for free-standing day hospital facilities. Please note that in each table title, a reference to the relevant question number on the collection form is shown in brackets.

State level data has been provided, where possible, for New South Wales, Victoria, Queensland, South Australia, Western Australia, Tasmania, Northern Territory and Australian Capital Territory.

In most tables, data has been rounded. This rounding can cause totals to be different to the combined values of the data shown in the tables.


