INTRODUCTION

This publication contains the results of the quarterly Survey of Tourist Accommodation (STA). The STA includes hotels, motels, guest houses and serviced apartments with 15 or more rooms.

DATA NOTES

The 'takings from accommodation' data collected from 1 July 2000 is on a GST inclusive basis. Care should be taken when comparing takings data from September quarter 2000 onwards with takings from previous quarters.

Some under-reporting of GST has been identified. Adjustments will be made in the next issue of this publication once further information collected from the June quarter 2001 survey has been evaluated. These adjustments are expected to increase takings data for the September quarter 2000 to March quarter 2001 by between 4% and 6%.

CHANGES IN THIS

From March quarter 2001 various changes have been made to some Statistical Local Areas (SLA) and Tourism Regions (TR) in South Australia. These changes have been made as a result of a request from the South Australian Tourist Commission. Areas that have changed are:

- Onkaparinga (C) Hills and South moved from Adelaide (TR) to Fleurieu Peninsula (TR)
- Northern Areas (DC) moved from Mid North (TR) to Flinders Ranges (TR)
- Wakefield (DC) and Mallala (DC) moved from Mid North (TR) to Yorke Peninsula (TR)
- The Coorong (DC) and Unincorp. Murray Mallee moved from Murraylands (TR) to South East (TR)
- Far North (TR) renamed Outback SA (TR)
- Mid North (TR) has been renamed Clare Valley (TR)
- Adelaide Hills (TR) has been created and includes seven SLA's moved from Adelaide (TR) (see the listing in the Composition of Tourism Regions section at the end of this publication)

INTRODUCTION

SCOPE

- Survey of Tourist Accommodation (STA). The STA is a mailout collection that completely enumerates all in-scope accommodation establishments. Survey results for all States and Territories and Australia are published in *Tourist Accommodation*, *Australia* (Cat. no. 8635.0)
- **2** From the March quarter 1998, the scope and collection strategy for the STA was changed to include only significant accommodation establishments (these are defined below).

1 This data service contains data for South Australia from the ABS quarterly

- **3** On a quarterly basis, the STA includes hotels, motels, guest houses and serviced apartments with 15 or more rooms.
- **4** Every third year beginning with 2000, the STA expands to also include:
- holiday flats, units and houses of letting entities with 15 or more rooms or units:
- caravan parks with 40 or more powered sites;
- visitor hostels with 25 or more bed spaces.
- **5** The short-term non-residential accommodation which is in scope of this survey is accommodation which is not let out on a lease basis, and which is let out to guests who would generally, although not necessarily, stay for periods of less than two months.
- **6** Some establishments included in the survey such as caravan parks also provide long-term residential accommodation. For hotels, motels, guest houses and serviced apartments, the amount of such activity is considered to be insignificant and is included in the data presented in this publication.
- **7** The STA currently includes the following categories of establishments which provide predominantly short-term non-residential accommodation to the general public:
- hotels and resorts with facilities establishments with 15 or more rooms which are licensed to operate a public bar and which provide accommodation on a room/suite basis, with a bath/shower and toilet in most guest rooms, but which do not have full cooking facilities (i.e. hot plates and oven/microwave) in most guest rooms;
- motels, private hotels and guest houses with facilities establishments with 15 or more rooms which are not licensed to operate a public bar, and which provide accommodation on a room/suite basis, with a bath/shower and toilet in most guest rooms, but which do not have full cooking facilities (i.e. hot plates and oven/microwave) in most guest rooms.
- serviced apartments establishments with 15 or more units which mostly comprise self-contained units at the same location, and which are available on a unit/apartment basis to the general public for a minimum of one night; the units should have full cooking facilities (i.e. hot plates and oven/microwave), refrigerator and bath/shower and toilet facilities; all bed linen and towels should be provided, and daily servicing (i.e. cleaning and bed making) must be available through the on-site management, although this service may not necessarily be used.

DEFINITIONS OF ACCOMMODATION ESTABLISHMENTS **CLASSIFICATION CHANGES**

8 As a result of the separate classification of serviced apartments from the March quarter 1998, there have been several changes to definitions of accommodation units. Some units, which were formerly in categories such as hotels, motels or holiday flats, units and houses are now classified as serviced apartments. A small number of establishments which were previously classified as motels have been reclassified as holiday flats, units and houses and are therefore no longer in scope of the quarterly STA, except as described in paragraph 4.

COVERAGE

9 Coverage is comprehensive and from the December quarter 1999, has been obtained from the Australian Automobile Association accommodation guide, which is updated twice yearly. This is supplemented by notification of new tourism developments and their likely opening dates in selected guides, major tourism journals and periodicals and newspapers. Periodic comparison to lists of accommodation establishments provided by the various Tourism Commissions and Industry Associations is also undertaken.

DATA QUALITY

- **10** The survey does not have a sample component and the data are not subject to sampling variability. However, other inaccuracies collectively referred to as non-sampling error november affect the data. These non-sampling errors november arise from a number of sources, including:
- errors in the reporting of data by respondents;
- errors in the process of capturing data;
- estimation for missing data; and
- definition and classification errors.

Every effort has been made to reduce non-sampling error to a minimum by careful design and testing of questionnaires, and efficient operating procedures and systems used to compile statistics.

- **11** The March quarter 2001 response rates were:
- 94% licensed hotels
- 93% motels and guest houses
- 100% serviced apartments

REGIONAL DATA

12 Survey results are aggregated to Tourism Regions as defined by relevant State and Territory Tourist Commissions or equivalent organisations. Details of the composition of Tourism Regions, including a map, follow. Small geographic area data presented in this data service have been classified according to the Australian Standard Geographical Classification (ASGC), Edition 2000 (Effective from 1 October 2000).

ANNUAL CAPACITY DATA

- **13** ABS releases counts of accommodation establishments and their capacity as at the end of December each year in respect of the pre-1998 scope of the survey (but recognising serviced apartments separately) as follows:
- hotels, motels and guest houses and serviced apartments with facilities and having five or more rooms;
- holiday flats, units and houses (other than those included with serviced apartments) which are operated by owners, managers or real estate agents who have sole letting rights to at least five flats, units or houses for short term letting;
- all caravan parks regardless of size; and
- all visitor hostels regardless of size.
- **14** As a result of classification changes applied from March quarter 1998 onward, data will not be comparable with that previously published for particular accommodation types.
- **15** These counts are published annually in a quarterly issue of Tourism Indicators, Australia (Cat. no. 8634.0).

STATISTICS AVAILABLE ON REQUEST

16 The ABS makes tourist accommodation data available on request, including statistics for past quarters, for specific areas and specific data items. For example, detailed employment statistics showing the number of full-time, part-time or casual employees may be available. Normally such data is made available on a fee for service basis.

periods only are included.

Star grading The grading of hotels, motels and guest houses with facilities and serviced

apartments based on the classification system used by members of the Australian Automobile Association (AAA). The gradings are allocated according to a points system based on the amenities and facilities available to guests. Details of the grading scheme are contained in the RACV-RAASA members' publication *Accommodation Australia*, or the individual tour guides produced by members of the AAA. For the purpose of classifying establishments to a star grading in this publication, 'half' star gradings are ignored (e.g. a two and a half star grading has

been shown as two star).

Takings from accommodation

Gross revenue from the provision of accommodation, including bed taxes. Takings from meals are excluded. Takings from accommodation for each month generally represent the takings received during that month. Where payments are received in advance of, or after, the provision of accommodation to guests, the monthly figure for takings from accommodation may not necessarily bear a direct relationship to the number of guests accommodated during the month.




