## MAIN FEATURES

Note: Survey estimates are subject to sampling variability, as explained in paragraph 30 below.

In June 1981 the estimated number of families (within the scope of the survey) was $3,887,700$ comprising $3,389,700$ married-couple families and 498,000 other families ( 98,700 with a male head and 399,300 with a female head).

In 40.9 per cent of married-couple families, both husband and wife were in the labour force. Of these, 60.1 per cent had dependent children present.

In 19.7 per cent of married-couple families where the husband was unemployed the wife was employed.

In $258, \mathbf{3 0 0}$ families, at least one member was unemployed. In 176,500 of these families at least one member was employed.
19.1 per cent of all families had no employed member, while 44.6 per cent had two or more employed members.
$1,283,800$ persons who were not members of families lived alone, and of these 3.5 per cent were unemployed.

426,900 persons ( 106,100 males and 320,800 females) aged 65 years and over were not members of a family, and of these $406,000(98,100$ males and 308,000 females) were living alone.

## EXPLANATORY NOTES

## Introduction

In June 1981 a survey, based on the monthly population survey, was conducted throughout Australia to provide details of the labour force status of family members, their relationship to the family head and family composition.
2. Some results are published in Persons Looking for Work, Australia, June 1981 (6222.0). These results include estimates of the number of families with some unemployment, families in which the husband or family head was unemployed and the family status of individuals looking for work.
3. This publication contains detailed information about the family status of individuals and the composition of families. Tables 1 to 9 show estimates of the family status of individuals classified by age. birthplace and other variables, while Tables 10 to 29 show information about married-couple and other families-for example. number of dependent children present, labour force status of husband, wife or family head.
4. The survey was based on a multi-stage area sample of private dwellings (about 30,000 houses, flats, etc.) and non-private dwellings (hotels, motels. etc.) and covered about two-thirds of one per cent of the population of Australia. The information was obtained from the occupants of selected dwellings by carefully chosen and specially trained interviewers, the interviews being conducted during the two weeks beginning on Monday 8 June 1981. The information obtained relates to the week before the interview (i.e. the survey week).

## Scope

5. The survey included all persons aged fifteen years and over except:
(a) members of the permanent defence forces:
(b) certain diplomatic personnel of overseas governments, customarily excluded from census and estimated populations;
(c) overseas visitors holidaying in Australia:
(d) members of non-Australian defence forces (and their dependants) stationed in Australia; and
(e) boarding school students, patients in hospitals and sanatoria and inmates of reformatories. gaols, and other institutions
6. In addition, 59,100 married-couple families where either the husband or the wife was out of scope of the survey (as defined in paragraph 5) or whose current period of absence from the household was expected to be more than six weeks, have been excluded from the family tables (Tables 10 to 29) in this publication. However. all persons who came within the scope of the survey were included in Tables 1 to 9 . For this reason, and because of the different weighting factors that were applied for each sex, the estimated number of husbands $(3,399,000)$ does not equal the estimated number of wives $(3.359,500)$ in Tables 3 and 5.
7. The labour force survey part of the population survey upon which this survey was based includes persons listed in paragraph 5(e). For this reason, as well as slightly different weighting procedures and the exclusion of permanently separated persons from the definition of the marriage relationship in this survey (see paragraph 25), estimates in this publication differ slightly from those that appear in Table 2 of the June 1981 issue of The Labour Force, Australia (6203.0).

## Definitions

8. The labour force category to which a person is assigned depends on his or her actual activity (i.e. whether working, looking for work, etc.) during the survey week. The following definitions, which conform closely to the international standard definitions specified by the International Labour Organisation (ILO), relate only to those persons within the scope of the survey.
9. Employed persons comprise all those aged 15 years and over who, during the survey week:
(a) worked for one hour or more for pay, profit, commission or payment in kind in a job or business, or on a farm (including employees. employers and self-employed persons); or
(b) worked for 15 hours or more without pay in a family business or on a farm (i.e. unpaid family helpers); or
(c) were employees who had a job but were not at work and were: on paid leave; on leave without pay for less than four weeks up to the end of the survey week; stood down without pay because of bad weather or plant breakdown at their place of employment for less than four weeks up to the end of the survey week; on strike or locked out; on workers' compensation and expected to be returning to their job; or receiving wages or salary while undertaking full-time study; or
(d) were employers or self-employed persons who had a job, business or farm, but were not at work.
10. Unemployed persons are those aged 15 years and over who were not employed during the survey week, and
(a) had actively looked for full-time or part-time work at any time in the four weeks up to the end of the survey week and:
(i) were available for work in the survey week, or would have been available except for temporary illness (i.e. lasting for less than four weeks to the end of the survey week); or
(ii) were waiting to start a new job within four weeks from the end of the survey week and would have started in the survey week if the job had been available then;
or (b) were waiting to be called back to a full-time or part-time job from which they had been stood down without pay for less than four weeks up to the end of the survey week (including the whole of the survey week) for reasons other than bad weather or plant breakdown.
11. The unemployment rate for any group is the number unemployed expressed as a percentage of the labour force in the same group.
12. The labour force comprises all persons who. during the survey week, were employed or unemployed. as defined in paragraphs 9 and 10 .
13. The labour force participation rate for any group is the labour force expressed as a percentage of the civilian population aged 15 years and over in the same group.
14. Full-time workers are those who usually work 35 hours or more a week and others who, although usually part-time workers, worked 35 hours or more during the survey week. Part-time workers are those who usually work less than 35 hours a week and who did so during the survey week.
15. Hours of work. The figures refer to actual hours worked during the survey week, not hours paid for. They may be affected by public holidays, leave, absenteeism; temporary absence from work due to sickness, injury, accident and industrial disputes; and stoppages of work due to bad weather, plant breakdown, etc. Fractions of an hour are disregarded and this results in slightly lower figures than would be the case if actual time worked was recorded.
16. Persons not in the labour force are those who. during the survey week, were not in the categories 'employed' or 'unemployed', as defined in paragraphs 9 and 10.
17. Persons classified by labour force status are classified according to whether or not they are in the labour force. Persons in the labour force classified by employment status are classified according to whether they are employed or unemployed. Employed persons classified by occupational status are classified according to whether they are employers, self-employed persons, wage and salary earners (employees), or unpaid family helpers (who worked 15 hours or more in the survey week).
18. Main English-speaking countries comprise the United Kingdom, Ireland, Canada, the United States of America, New Zealand and South Africa.
19. Other countries comprise all countries outside Australia other than the main English-speaking countries mentioned in paragraph 18.
20. A dwelling may contain one or more households. and separate households were considered to exist within a dwelling when:
(a) a group of one or more persons considered themselves to be a separate household from others in the dwelling;
(b) regular provision was made for groups to take meals at different times or in different rooms; or
(c) a dwelling contained one or more lodgers. who received accommodation, but no meals; each lodger was then considered to be a separate household.

A household may consist of any number of families and non-family members. A boarder who received both accommodation and meals was not considered to constitute a separate household.
21. A person was considered to be living alone if he or she was the sole member of a household. Thus, a person who was the sole occupant of a self-contained flat attached to a nother dwelling was considered to be living alone.
22. A family was generally defined to consist of two or more persons living in the same household at the time of the survey, comprising the family head and spouse (if any) and any persons having any of the following relationships to them:
(a) sons or daughters of any age, if not married and with no children of their own present;
(b) brothers or sisters, if not married and not accompanied by parents, nor with children of their own present;
(c) grandchildren, if not married and not accompanied by either of their parents, nor with children of their own present;
(d) ancestors, if not married and not accompanied by children under 15 years of age of their own; or
(e) any children under 15 years of age not accompanied by a parent, unless the children were related to some person in a second family in the household.
23. The following points should be noted in relation to the definition of a family in the previous paragraph:
(a) family status was determined at the time of the survey. Thus, if members of a family were absent from the household (for example children at boarding schools) the family status of the family head and other members could have been affected;
(b) the term relationship includes relationships by blood, marriage or adoption;
(c) the marriage relationship includes legal and de facto marriages;
(d) not-married is as defined in paragraph 25 ;
(e) a family, as defined, can contain no more than two married persons, and can contain two married persons only if these persons are husband and wife;
(f) visitors to a household are persons who are not considered to be usual members of the household, and regardless of relationship to members of the household or duration of stay, they were not included in the survey.
24. Dependent children comprise all family members under 15 years of age and all family members aged 15 to 20 years who are full-time students. Dependent children were regarded as present and hence were included in the survey provided they were not living away from the household (for example, at boarding school) at the time of the survey.
25. The term not-married comprises never married, widowed, divorced, and permanently separated persons (see paragraph 23(c) on de facto relationships).
26. Persons were defined as not a member of a family if they were living alone (as defined in paragraph 21 ) or they were not related to any other member of the household in which they were living (see paragraphs 23(b) and 23(c).
27. A married-couple family was defined as a family where both husband and wife were living in the household at the time of the interview, or where one or both were absent for a period not exceeding six weeks.
28. Other families were families other than marriedcouple families as defined above. In addition to singleparent families, this category included families in which the head was not a parent, for example a family head living with a brother or sister.

## Comparability of series

29. Estimates for the July 1979, July 1980 and June 1981 surveys are based on revised population estimates derived from the results of the 1976 Population Census (adjusted for underenumeration) and a revised population survey questionnaire. Therefore care should be used in comparing estimates from these surveys with those obtained from earlier surveys.

## Reliability of the estimates

30. Since the estimates in this publication are based on information obtained from occupants of a sample of dwellings, they may differ from the figures that would have been produced if the information had been obtained from occupants of all dwellings. More information on this topic is given in the Technical note.

## Related publications

31. The November 1974 issue of this publication shows information about the characteristics of the family (as in Tables 10 to 29 of this issue), but not about the family status of individuals (Tables 1 to 9). The publication Family Status and Employment Status of the Population, November 1974 and November 1975 (6223.0) shows information about the family status of individuals, but not about the characteristics of the family. (See paragraph 29 for information about the comparability of estimates published prior to the July 1979 issue of this publication.)

## TECHNICAL NOTE

## Estimation procedure

The estimates are derived from the population survey by use of a complex ratio estimation procedure, which ensures that the survey estimates conform to an independently estimated distribution of the population by age and sex, rather than to the age and sex distribution within the sample itself.

## Reliability of the estimates

2. Since the estimates in this publication are based on information obtained from occupants of a sample of dwellings, they are subject to sampling variability; that is, they may differ from the figures that would have been produced if all dwellings had been included. One measure of the likely difference is given by the standard error, which indicates the extent to which an estimate might have varied by chance because only a sample of dwellings was included in the survey. There are about two chances in three that a sample estimate will differ by less than one standard error from the figure that would have been obtained if all dwellings had been included in the survey, and about nineteen chances in twenty that the difference will be less than two standard errors.
3. Space does not allow for the separate indication of the standard errors of all estimates in this publication. A table of standard errors for general application is given below. These figures will not give a precise measure of the standard error of a particular estimate since they are averages based on calculations for a limited number of past surveys over a wide range of labour force characteristics. However, they will provide an indication of the magnitude of the standard error. An example of the calculation and use of standard errors is as follows. The estimated number of families with a not-married female
head is 399,300 . From the table below it will be seen that this estimate has a standard error of about 6,600 and therefore there are about two chances in three that the value that would have been produced if all dwellings had been included in the survey will fall within the range 392,700 to 405,900 and about nineteen chances in twenty that it will fall within the range 386,100 to 412,500 .
4. The reliability of an estimated percentage computed by using sample data for both numerator and denominator depends upon both the size of the numerator and the size of the denominator. However, the per cent standard error of the estimated percentage will generally be lower than the per cent standard error of the estimate of the numerator. The per cent standard error of the numerator can be obtained from the table below.
5. As the standard errors in the table below show, the smaller the estimate the higher is the relative standard error. Very small estimates are thus subject to such high standard errors (relative to the size of the estimate) as to detract seriously from their value for most reasonable uses. In the tables in this publication, estimates less than 4,500 have not been shown. Although figures for these small components can in some cases be derived by subtraction, they should not be regarded as reliable.
6. The imprecision due to sampling variability, which is measured by the standard error, should not be confused with inaccuracies that may occur because of imperfections in reporting by interviewers and respondents. Inaccuracies of this kind are referred to as the non-sampling error, and they may occur in any enumeration, whether it be a full count or a sample. Every effort is made to reduce the non-sampling error to a minimum by careful design of questionnaires, intensive training and supervision of interviewers and efficient operating procedures.
