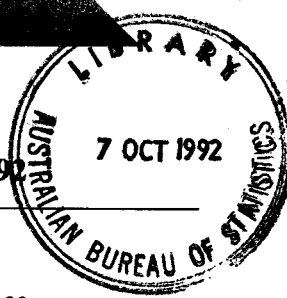

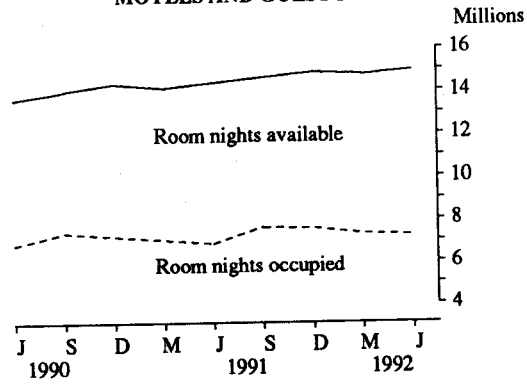


CHART 2: QUARTERLY OCCUPANCY RATES

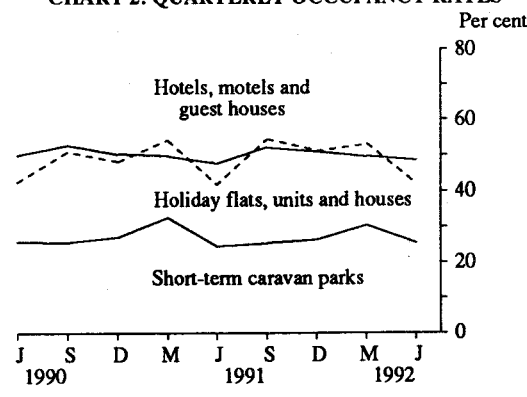
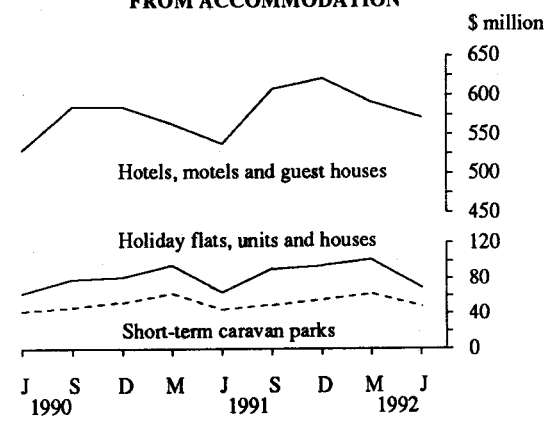


CHART 3: QUARTERLY TAKINGS FROM ACCOMMODATION



From June quarter 1991 to June quarter 1992:

HOTELS, MOTELS AND GUEST HOUSES

- Rooms available increased by 3.9 per cent overall to 164,739 with the only significant decrease being recorded in Australian Capital Territory.
- Room nights occupied increased by 5.9 per cent to 7.25m with all States and Territories recording increases.
- The room occupancy rate overall increased by 0.9 percentage points to 48.5 per cent. Highest increases were for Queensland and Australian Capital Territory at 3.0 and 12.0 percentage points respectively while New South Wales and Tasmania recorded decreases.
- Takings from accommodation increased by 6.0 per cent to \$570.9m. Average takings per room night remained unchanged at \$79 while the Consumer Price Index rose by 1.2 per cent.

CARAVAN PARKS (SHORT-TERM AND LONG-TERM)

- Sites available increased by 0.8 per cent to 287,013 while the number of site nights occupied increased by 2.3 per cent from 8.54m to 8.73m.
- The site occupancy rate consequently increased from 33.0 per cent to 33.5 per cent.
- Accommodation takings increased by 7.6 per cent to \$90.2m.

HOLIDAY FLATS, UNITS AND HOUSES

- The number of units available for short term letting increased by 2.6 per cent to 33,147, while unit nights occupied at 1.27m was an increase of 3.3 per cent.
- The unit occupancy rate consequently increased from 41.7 per cent to 42.0 per cent.
- Accommodation takings increased by 8.9 per cent to \$70.1m.

Expanded Scope

VISITOR HOSTELS

- Visitor hostels have been added to the scope of the survey as from September quarter 1991.
- In the June quarter 1992, visitor hostels offered 24,493 bed spaces and sold 0.94m guest nights at an average \$11 per night for a total of \$10.7m takings from accommodation. This compared with 1.01m guest nights sold in March quarter 1992 for \$11.4m.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

Introduction

This publication contains data, for Australia and each State and Territory, from a quarterly survey of tourist accommodation establishments. The period covered by the latest survey is the three months ended 30 June 1992.

New Feature

2. Commencing with September quarter 1991, the scope of the survey has been expanded to include visitor hostels (backpacker establishments) available to the general public for short-term commercial accommodation. This publication contains data for visitor hostels for the March and June quarters 1992.

Scope and Coverage

3. Tourist accommodation establishments currently included in the survey comprise two groups:

(a) Establishments providing predominantly short-term accommodation (i.e. for periods of less than two months) to the general public. These include:

(i) *Hotels, motels and guest houses, with facilities.* Hotels licensed to operate a public bar and motels, private hotels and guest-houses all of which provide a bath (or shower) and toilet in most guest rooms and have breakfast available for guests.

(ii) *Holiday flats, units and houses* (excluding establishments predominantly operated on a time share basis) which are operated by owners or managers who have sole letting rights to at least 5 flats, units or houses or by real estate agents for short-term letting. They are mainly self-contained in terms of cooking, bath (or shower) and toilet facilities and do not have breakfast available for guests. Data for holiday flats, units and houses include short-term owner occupation as well as paying guest occupation.

(iii) *Visitor hostels* which provide accommodation to visitors on a bed basis (rather than by the room). This category does not include establishments providing charity type accommodation (e.g. Salvation Army hostels) nor hotels, motels and guest houses without in-room facilities which provide accommodation on a per room basis.

(b) *Caravan parks* providing either predominantly short-term (i.e. for periods of less than two months) or predominantly long-term (i.e. for periods of two months or more) accommodation to the general public and which provide powered sites for caravans and toilet, shower and laundry facilities for guests.

4. Data collected and published for each type of establishment (other than holiday flats, units and houses) include both long-term and short-term guests at these establishments.

5. Establishments providing more than one type of accommodation (e.g. a motel with attached caravan park) are treated as two or more separate establishments. However, self-contained units, flats, cabins etc. attached to hotels, motels or to caravan parks are included in the capacity for those establishments and not treated as separate holiday flat, unit or house establishments.

Definitions

6. *Number of establishments.* For hotels, motels etc., caravan parks and visitor hostels, the number of establishments within the scope of the survey which operated for any part of the survey period, or which closed temporarily for the quarter for seasonal reasons.

7. *Number of letting entities.* For holiday flats, units and houses, the number of owners, managers or real estate agents within the scope of the survey who operated for any part of the survey period.

8. *Capacity in terms of Guest rooms, Bed spaces, Holiday units or Caravan park sites etc.* is the maximum number available to accommodate paying guests during the survey period.

9. *Bed spaces.* Three-quarter beds are counted as one bed space; double beds as two bed spaces. Excludes cots.

10. *Total caravan park capacity* includes *On-site vans, Other powered sites, Unpowered sites and Cabins, etc.*

11. *Room nights available.* The number of guest rooms available multiplied by the number of days for which they were available during the survey period.

12. *Occupancy in terms of Room nights, Unit nights or Site nights occupied* refers to the total number of nights each guest room, holiday unit or caravan park site etc. was occupied by a paying guest during the survey period.

13. *Occupancy in terms of Guest nights* refers to the total number of nights each paying guest stayed during the survey period.

14. *Sites occupied by long-term guests.* The total number of sites etc. occupied at the end of the survey period by guests who have stayed continuously for 2 months or more.

15. *Occupancy rates* represent actual occupancy expressed as a percentage of total capacity available during the survey period - e.g.

$$\text{Room occupancy rate (\%)} \text{ for the period} = \frac{\text{Room nights occupied}}{(\text{Guest rooms}) \times (\text{No. of days in the period})} \times 100$$

16. *Guest arrivals.* The total number of paying guests counted only on the first night they stayed at the accommodation establishment.

17. *Unit lettings.* The total number of times a holiday flat, unit or house was occupied by a new tenant, counted only on the first night it was occupied by the new tenant.

18. *Average length of stay* is expressed in number of days and calculated:

(a) for hotels and motels etc. and visitor hostels, by dividing guest nights by guest arrivals; and

(b) for holiday flats, units and houses, by dividing unit nights occupied by unit lettings.

19. *Takings from accommodation.* Revenue received from the provision of accommodation. Takings from meals are excluded. Takings from accommodation for each month generally represent the takings received during that month. Where payments are received in advance of, or after, the provision of accommodation to guests, the monthly figure for takings from accommodation may not necessarily bear a direct relationship to the number of guests accommodated during the month. Rental and storage fees paid to caravan parks for the keeping of private vans in parks are included in the takings of the month they are received.

20. *Star grading.* The grading of hotels and motels with facilities based on the classification system used by members of the Australian Automobile Association (AAA). The gradings are allocated according to a points system based on the amenities and facilities available to guests. Details of the grading scheme are contained in the RACV-RAASA members' publication *Accommodation Australia*, or the individual tour guides produced by members of the AAA. For the purpose of classifying establishments to a star grading in this publication, 'half' star gradings are ignored (e.g. a two and a half star grading has been shown as two star).

21. *Employment.* The number of persons working at accommodation establishments at the end of the survey period (including those working on other than accommodation activities). Although unpublished, employment data are available upon request from the ABS.

Unpublished Statistics

22. The ABS may also make available on request certain unpublished tourist accommodation statistics, including employment statistics. A charge may be made for this information.
