RETAIL SALES OF GOODS : AUSTRALIAMONTH OF JANUARY 1967 (PROVISIONAL)

A provisional estimate of the total value of retail sales in Australia (excluding motor vehicles, parts, petrol, etc.) for the month of January 1967, is shown in the table below. This table also contains figures for earlier months.

2. Provisional monthly estimates are obtained from a sub-sample of establishments used to provide quarterly estimates of the value of retail sales. The sub-sample is designed to provide an estimate lying within a relatively small range above or below the true figure so as to give an early indication of trend. Undue significance should not be attached to very small movements or to the exact magnitude of any movements shown by these provisional estimates. These estimates are subsequently adjusted in accordance with the preliminary and final quarterly estimates as they become available.

3. Month to month changes in retail sales figures are affected by seasonal factors and also by differences in the number of days in each month and by variation in type of trading days (the number of Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, etc. in the month). Adjustments for these factors have not been made in the sales estimates in this bulletin.

4. The provisional figures previously published for the months of October, November and December, 1966 have now been adjusted in accordance with the preliminary estimates for December quarter, 1966. See Statistical Bulletin "Retail Sales of Goods" December quarter 1966 (Preliminary) of 1 March 1967.

5. Further information relating to the basis on which the statistics of retail sales of goods are compiled, is contained in Statistical Bulletin "Retail Sales of Goods" September quarter 1966 of 10 January 1967.
