RETAIL SALES OF GOODS : AUSTRALIAMONTH OF FEBRUARY, 1962 (PROVISIONAL)

The table below contains a provisional estimate of the total value of retail sales of goods (excluding Motor Vehicles, Parts, Petrol, etc.) in Australia for the month of February, 1962. For purposes of comparison, figures for some earlier periods are also shown.
