Policy makers now have access to better data on road freight movements to inform future road planning, thanks to a joint Federal and State funded report by the Australian Bureau of Statistics (ABS). 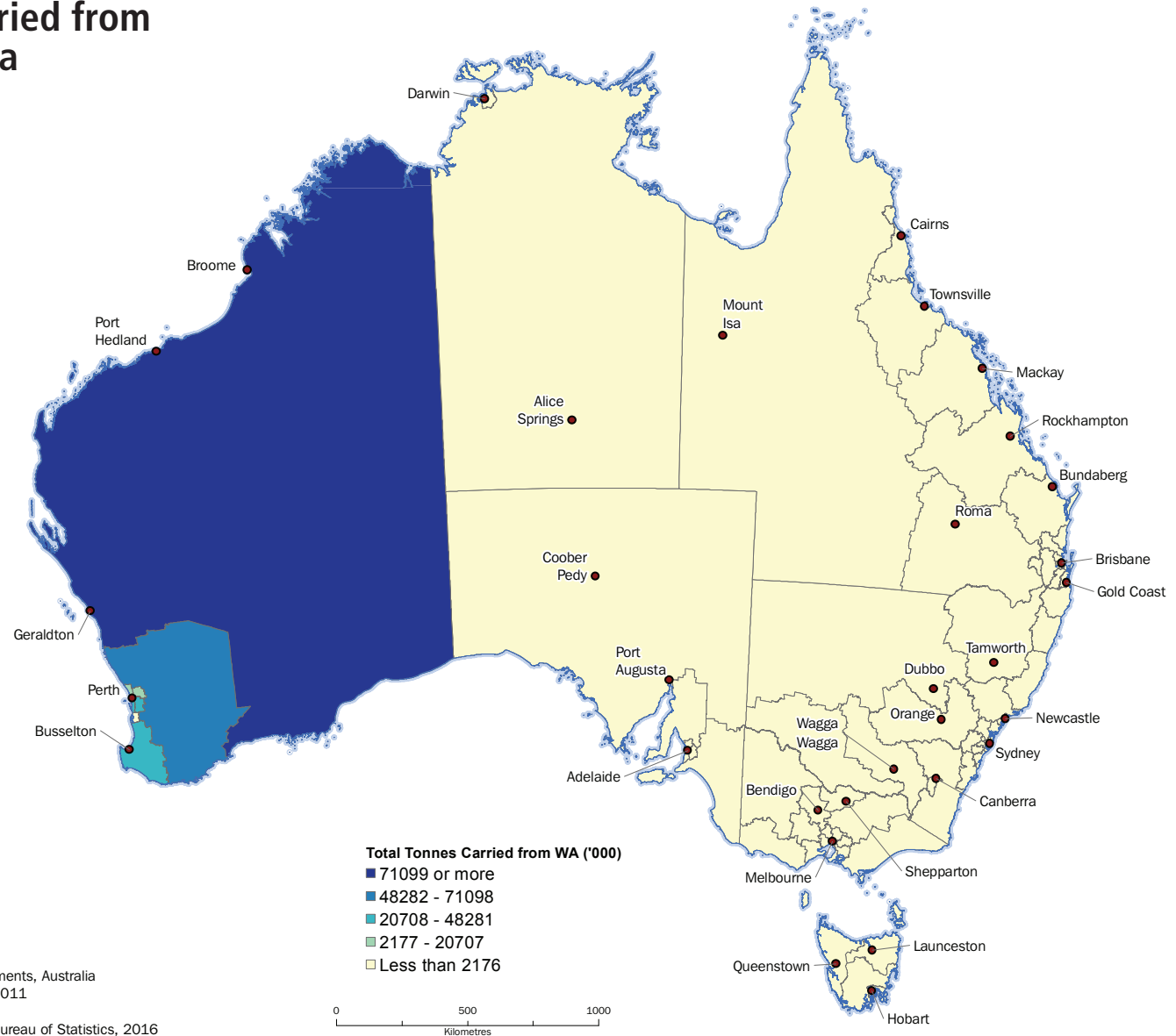
