

Less experienced researchers may apply for access to microdata in the ABS DataLab if they are referred by a more experienced researcher.

The referring researcher must:

- have at least three years of either quantitative research experience or university study with a significant component working with quantitative data
- be working on the same project within the DataLab as the less experienced researcher
- agree to direct, supervise and take responsibility for the work of the less experienced researcher, and
- have the agreement of a Senior Executive from the less experienced researcher's organisation for this referral.
