EXPANDED COMMUNITY PROFILE EXPLANATORY NOTES

INTRODUCTION

- 1. The Expanded Community Profile contains 41 tables available for Statistical Local Areas (SLAs) and larger areas, comprising more detailed versions of some of the basic profile tables, plus new tables for the following geographic levels: SLA, LGA, SSD, SD, S. Dist., State, Australia.
- 2. Information was collected from the 1996 Census of Population and Housing.
- 3. Each table title in the Expanded Community Profile consists of two parts. The first part lists the variables included in the table. The second part describes the table population.
- 4. A glossary of terms and concepts used in the Expanded Community Profile appears below.

GLOSSARY

Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander Origin

6. The 1996 Census was the first census to allow a person's origin to be recorded as both Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander; prior to this only one or the other could be recorded.

Employed full-time/part-time

7. 'Employed full-time' means that the person worked 35 hours or more in all jobs held during the week prior to Census night. 'Employed part-time' means that the person worked less than 35 hours in all jobs during the week prior to Census night.

8. For Census purposes, people who stated they were employed, but worked zero hours in the week prior to Census night have been coded to 'employed part-time'.

Family

9. A family is defined as two or more persons, one of whom is at least 15 years of age, who are related by blood, marriage (registered or de facto), adoption, step or fostering, and who are usually resident in the same household. Family tables include same sex couples unless otherwise indicated.

Family Income

10. Family income is the sum of the personal incomes of each resident family member aged 15 years and over. Family income is not applicable to non-family households such as group households or lone person households; or to people in non-private dwellings.

Household

11. A household is defined as a group of two or more related or unrelated people who usually reside in the same dwelling, who regard themselves as a household, and who make common provision for food or other essentials for living; or a person living in a dwelling who makes provision for his/her own food and other essentials for living, without combining with any other person.

12. For Census purposes, the total number of households is equal to the total number of occupied private dwellings.

Household income

13. Household income is the sum of the personal incomes of each resident household member aged 15 years and over. If any household member did not state their income, or was temporarily absent, household income is not calculated. These families fall into the 'Partial income stated' category.

Nfd

14. Nfd means 'not further defined'.

Overseas visitor

15. In the 1996 Census, overseas visitors were treated differently compared to previous censuses. In 1996, age, sex and registered marital status were the only person variables recorded for overseas visitors, whereas in previous censuses, information on all topics at the person level was recorded. For further information, please contact the ABS and request a copy of Census Fact Sheet 15.

Place of enumeration

16. The Census count, based on place of enumeration, is a count of every person who spent Census night in Australia. People are counted where they are on Census night, which may not be where they usually live.

Social Marital Status

17. Social Marital Status is the relationship status of an individual with reference to another person who is usually resident in the household. A marriage exists when the two people live together as husband and wife, or partners, regardless of whether the marriage is formalised through registration. In the 1996 Census, where information about same-sex couples is volunteered in the relationship question, it is included in the family coding and classified as a partner in a de facto marriage.

| Table population     | 18. Table population is a description of what the table is counting. For example, tables containing marital status usually have a table population of persons aged 15 years and over. | Tenure type          | 19. In the 1996 Census, the number of categories in the tenure type classification has increased and now includes 'being purchased under a rent/buy scheme', 'being occupied rent free' and 'being occupied under a life tenure scheme'.                                                                                                                                                                                                           |
| DATA QUALITY         | 20. The Census is subject to a number of inaccuracies resulting from errors by respondents or mistakes in collection or processing of the data. Some of these are overcome or 'repaired' by careful processing procedures and quality management of the processing itself. The effect of those that remain is generally slight, although it may be more important for small groups in the population. The main kinds of error to keep in mind are: |
| Partial non-response | 21. In some cases where an answer was not provided to a question an answer was imputed or derived (often from other information on the form). In other cases a 'not stated' code was allocated.                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                    |
| Processing error     | 22. While such errors can occur in any processing system, quality management is used to continuously improve the quality of processed data, and to identify and correct data of unacceptable quality.                                                                                                                                                                                                                                              |
| Random adjustment    | 23. Cells containing small values are randomly adjusted to avoid releasing information about particular individuals, families or households. | Respondent error     | 24. | Household Income (HIND) and Family Income (FINF) | 26. Due to operational limitations, the family/household income imputation methodology may result in an undercount of the number of families/households in the \$1,500 - \$1,999 range and a balancing overcount in the \$2,000 range. No other income ranges are affected. This may also affect the median income estimate if the median falls in either of these ranges.<br><br>27. The calculation of median income is based on imputations made from the Survey of Income and Housing Costs, and as such is subject to sampling error. This is particularly evident if the median falls into the highest income range, where the quoted median is a proxy only and should be regarded with caution.<br><br>28.
