P R E F A C E

This publication shows, for the State of South Australia, the numbers of occupied and unoccupied dwellings and of males, females and persons in each locality with twenty or more dwellings (occupied or unoccupied) or fifty or more persons. It also shows separately the numbers of occupied dwellings and total persons on rural holdings in each of these localities.

This is one of five parts which will constitute the complete Census Volume for the State of South Australia, viz., Part I.—Analysis of Population in Local Government Areas and in Non-municipal Towns of 1,000 Persons or More; Part II.—Cross-classifications of the Characteristics of the Population; Part III.—Analysis of Dwellings in Local Government Areas and in Non-municipal Towns of 1,000 Persons or More; Part IV.—Cross-classifications of the Characteristics of Dwellings and of Householders; and Part V.—Population and Dwellings in Localities.

In addition, a number of supplementary statements in mimeographed form are being issued. A list of printed and mimeographed 1961 Census publications already issued is shown inside the back cover of this Part.

Explanatory notes relative to the contents of the Part follow this Preface.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

The particulars shown in this Part relate to the numbers of the population and dwellings (occupied and unoccupied) in cities, towns and other localities throughout South Australia in which twenty or more dwellings or fifty or more persons were enumerated at the Census of 30th June, 1961. In addition to the total population and dwellings enumerated in each locality, the number of occupied dwellings and population enumerated therein stated to be situated on rural holdings of one acre or more are shown. A rural holding for Census purposes is one on which agricultural, pastoral, dairying, &c., operations are carried on.

All dwellings enumerated in the rural sections of the State have been allotted to localities, and details of localities which at Census date had less than twenty dwellings and a population of less than fifty persons are therefore available in the Census records, although not published in this Part.

Particulars of any locality the population of which was wholly or mainly included in an urban area (i.e. Metropolitan Area of Adelaide, any urban Municipality or an urban part of a Municipality, or any Non-municipal Town of 1,000 persons or more) have not been separately tabulated. However, total populations of such urban areas and of their constituent local government areas, where applicable, have been shown. To distinguish these from individual localities they have been indicated as follows:—

An amalgamation of several urban Municipalities—Capital letters, e.g. ADELAIDE, METROPOLITAN AREA OF.

An urban Municipality or an urban part of a Municipality—Capital letter and small capitals, e.g. BRIGHTON, RENMARK—URBAN PART.

A Non-municipal Town—Capital letter and lower case with the letters N.M. in parenthesis, e.g. Angaston (N.M.).

Similarly, the numbers of occupied dwellings and persons on rural holdings in these areas have not been tabulated because of the predominantly urban nature of the areas. Where a major proportion of the population of a locality was situated *outside* the boundaries of any such area, separate particulars are shown for that portion of the locality only, but not for the portion situated inside.

In rural areas clearly defined boundaries of towns and other localities are seldom available, and the figures shown have been derived from Census schedules relating to the dwellings which were stated to be within the generally accepted limits of the town or locality specified. Details of towns were compiled separately wherever the requisite information was available from Census Collectors or from Census maps. In the absence of information necessary to separate the town from the surrounding district, the whole area has been regarded as one locality, which therefore may cover a very wide area, especially in the less densely settled areas of the State. Dwellings located beyond the limits of a town for which details were separately recorded, and which were in an area which had no other recognized name, were recorded as "near" the appropriate town. In such cases, details are shown for both town and "near" where either had twenty or more dwellings or a population of fifty or more persons.

Information concerning dwellings and population on rural holdings is provided in order to give a better appreciation of the nature of the locality.

Following the procedure used for the 1954 Census, boundaries have been determined for towns with a population of 1,000 persons or more which were not separately incorporated for purposes of local government. Such towns have been termed Non-municipal Towns and are indicated in Census publications by the addition of the letters "N.M." after the name of the town.

For each locality situated within a local government area the name of that local government area has been shown. "Not Incorporated" has been used in the column headed "Local Government Area" to indicate localities situated in parts of the State not incorporated for purposes of local government. Maps showing the boundaries of local government areas will be found in Part I. of this Volume.

The last section of this Part shows for each local government area the localities recorded within it and their respective populations. "Near" localities (except in certain important cases) and localities within the Metropolitan Area of Adelaide and any urban Municipality are excluded.

The particulars of this Part exclude the numbers of full-blood aboriginals and of dwellings occupied solely by them.

Wherever practicable, information concerning "construction" and other settlements or camps is shown separately from the general town population. Particulars of military camps or other defence establishments are not shown.

For the purposes of the Census, an "occupied dwelling" is any habitation occupied by a household group living together as a domestic unit, whether comprising the whole or only part of a building. The term has, therefore, a very wide reference, and includes, in addition to houses and flats, a great variety of "dwellings" ranging from a single-roomed shack to a multi-roomed hotel or institution.

"Unoccupied dwellings" include vacant dwellings available for sale or renting; dwellings such as "week-ender", "holiday home", "second home", "seasonal workers' quarters", which were not occupied on the night of the Census; dwellings normally occupied but whose usual occupants were temporarily absent on the night of the Census; newly completed dwellings whose owners or tenants had not entered into occupation on the night of the Census; dwellings described as "condemned", "awaiting demolition", "deceased estate", "exhibition home", &c.; and buildings constructed as dwellings but used for non-dwelling purposes on the night of the Census. The total number of unoccupied dwellings shown for any area must not, therefore, be read as representing the number of vacant houses and flats available for sale or renting.
