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## INTRODUCTION

- 1** This publication provides information concerning the sample file on floppy disk which contains unit record data from the 1994 National Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Survey (NATSIS). This file, called The National Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Survey Confidentialised Unit Record File (CURF), is now available.
- 2** The Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Survey, conducted throughout Australia during April to July 1994, obtained information about the social, economic and cultural status, conditions and attitudes of Australia's Indigenous population. This is the first time such a wide ranging and comprehensive survey of Australia's Indigenous people has been conducted by the ABS or any other agency.
- 3** The survey has its origins in the Royal Commission into Aboriginal Deaths in Custody. Recommendation 49 of this Commission's Report requires that a comprehensive survey of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people be conducted to collect the information, the Commission found to be lacking and believed to be important to Aboriginal self-determination.
- 4** The sample design was a multistage stratified random sample based on census collection districts (CDs) as the primary sampling unit. Stratification was determined by ATSIC regions, whether larger or small CD, and by section-of-state.
- 5** The survey covers the total sample of 4,205 households, which yielded 15,726 Indigenous respondents, which includes 3,907 non-Indigenous people lived in household and prisoners. A total 90 Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people were involved in conducting interviews for the survey.
- 6** All the information was obtained by personal interviews for people aged 13 years or more and interviews with an appropriate adult for people aged 12 years or less.
- 7** There are six survey questionnaires, one for each of the following types of units:
  - adult (13+ years)
  - Child (12 years and under)
  - Household
  - Community
  - Special dwelling
  - Prisoner.

Besides basic demographic variables, they collected information in six areas:

- Family and Culture
- Health
- Housing
- Education and Training
- Employment and Income
- Law and Justice.

Much of the information collected was, intentionally, concerned with people's attitudes and perceptions, while other information was concerned with facts, as understood by respondents. A third type of information concerned respondent's beliefs and value systems.

- 8** Estimates from the survey, as well as more information on the methodology, scope, and definitions used in the survey, are published in *National Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Survey 1994: Detailed*

*Findings* (Cat. No. 4190.0) and ATSIC Regional estimates are published in *National Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Survey 1994: Regional Statistics* (Cat. No. 4196.0.00.001 to 037).

## RELEASE OF THE DATA

**9** The release of the data is possible under the Census and Statistics Act 1905, which has provision for the release of data in the form of confidential unit record file (CURF) where 'the information is not likely to enable the identification of a particular person or organisation'. Accordingly, there are no names or addresses of survey respondents on the CURF and the detail for some data items has been suppressed or reduced (top-coded) to ensure that the confidentiality of individuals is protected.

**10** The CURF will only be provided under certain conditions of issue (specified in the Licence Conditions on pages 14 to 17). Subject to the limitations of sample size and the data classifications used, it is possible for you to manipulate the data, produce tabulations and undertake statistical analyses to your specifications.

## FILE AND RECORD STRUCTURE

**11** The CURF is available on IBM compatible floppy disks. The data files will be provided on two appropriately labelled disks, in a highly compressed format. Public domain software, together with associated documentation, will be provided to enable you to de-compress the files.

**12** A number of files associated with the survey:

- i    README.TXT  
This file contains details of all the URF files.
- ii    COPYRIGHT.TXT  
This file contains the ABS copyright warning notice.
- iii    ATI94DOC.TXT  
This is a print file and contains standard ANSI control characters. A purchaser may print this file to obtain extensive documentation including frequency tables, about the survey data items in ATI94URT.DAT.
- iv    ATI94DOC.FMT  
This is a compressed and formatted version of ATI94DOC.TXT which a purchaser may load into their system for ADP purposes. Each record in this file contains 148 bytes. The basic difference between this file and ATI94DOC.TXT, the carriage return (printer control) character and superfluous blank characters have been removed, and fields have been placed in specific positions within the records, together with identifiers to enable interpretation. If the purchaser is familiar with SAS, this file can be used in conjunction with ATI94INP.SAS to generate an input program.
- v    ATI94INP.SAS  
This file contains SAS code which can be used in conjunction with ATI94DOC.FMT to generate an input program.
- vi    ATI94URT.DAT  
This file contains a series of 36 976 records, made up of 18 753 person records, 8 525 income unit records, 5 510 family records and 4 188 household records. Each person record is 787 characters long. Each income unit record is 31 characters long. Each Family record is 49 characters long and each household record is 141 characters long.

## USING THE DATA

**1.3** Some changes have been made to data items from main and some have been totally deleted to avoid the release of identifiable information. Few new variables have been constructed by combining existing variables for reasons of data quality or confidentiality. Beside this the data file will not be matched with any other survey files because of the lack of consistency between sources on defining the population, lack of geography and poor coverage.

### New Derived data items

	<p><b>14</b> The data items which are on the CURF are listed in Appendix A. All zero values for data items have the label "Not applicable" unless otherwise stated.</p>
Sampling error	<p><b>15</b> Any statistics produced from the CURF will be subject to sampling errors. Tables of the standard errors (which are a measure of sampling error) are provided with the CURF. For more information on some non-sampling errors see the attached document: <i>ABS internal working paper on some aspects of non-sampling error issues for 1994 National Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Survey</i>.</p>
Estimation Procedure	<p><b>16</b> Estimates of numbers of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander persons with particular characteristics were derived from the survey by using a complex ratio estimation procedure which ensures that the survey estimates conform to both an independently estimated distribution of the population by age and sex at Capital city/Balance of State level, and an independently estimated distribution of the population across the 35 ATSIC Regions and the Torres Strait area. For more information see <i>1994 National Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Survey: Detailed Findings</i> (ABS Cat.No. 4190.0).</p>
RECONCILIATION WITH PUBLISHED DATA	<p><b>17</b> As a result of the steps that have been taken to preserve confidentiality, it is not possible to reconcile exactly some data produced from the CURF with published data.</p>
SECONDARY PROVIDERS	<p><b>18</b> The term 'secondary provider' applies to any person or organisation who obtains data from the ABS and then disseminates products to a third party where the major component of such products is statistical data obtained from the ABS. Persons or organisations preparing consultant or research reports that rely on ABS data are not usually regarded as secondary providers where research and analysis is the major component of the reports.</p>
CHARGES	<p><b>19</b> However, if you are likely to be providing data from the CURF to others, please contact Tony Barnes on (089) 43 2190 to discuss your usage/obligations before completing the order form.</p>
CONDITION OF ISSUES	<p><b>20</b> The price for the CURF, as at April 1996 is \$5,500. The price includes freight and handling charges to a destination within Australia. Overseas customers are required to pay the appropriate freight charge.</p>
	<p><b>21</b> The CURF is released under strict conditions. Prior to completing the CURF order form, you should carefully read the Licence Conditions described on Pages 9 to 11.</p>
	<p><b>22</b> The CURF is released in accordance with a Ministerial Determination (Clause 7, Statutory Rules 1983, No. 19) in pursuance of Section 13 of the Census and Statistics Act 1905. As required by the determination, the CURF has been designed so that the information on the file will not enable the identification of the particular persons to which it relates.</p>
	<p><b>23</b> In pursuance of Clause 7, the Determination requires you to sign an Undertaking (see pages 14 to 15) that the information will be used for statistical purposes only.</p>
	<p><b>24</b> Use of data for statistical purposes means use, by the person or organisation who has given the Undertaking, to produce information of a statistical nature. Examples of statistical purposes are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• the manipulation of the data to produce means, correlations or other descriptive or summary measures;</li></ul>

- the estimation of population characteristics from sample data;
- the use of data as input to mathematical models or for other types of analysis (e.g. factor analysis); and
- to provide graphical or pictorial representations of the characteristics of the population or subsets of the population.

**25** Use of the data for improper purposes may render you liable to severe penalties. For further information about the propriety of any particular intended use of the data, please contact the ABS.

**26** Note that access to any of the data or files on the CURF is restricted to the person or organisation who has given the Undertaking. Other potential users of the data must therefore make separate application to the ABS.

**27** Should you wish to change the Licence Conditions in any way, you will need to discuss your intended changes with Tony Barnes.

**28** Please submit your orders on the form provided on pages 12 to 13. The order form, which asks for your formatting requirements etc., should be completed with the assistance of someone with technical knowledge of the computer system to be used to process the files.

**29** Please ensure that the Licence Conditions and the Undertaking are signed by someone authorised to sign legal documents on behalf of your organisation and that a copy of each is retained by your organisation.

**30** Note that we can not process your order unless we have received your payment together with fully completed and signed Order Form, Undertaking and Licence Conditions.

## **INFORMATION REGARDING THE PURCHASE OF AUSTRALIAN BUREAU OF STATISTICS CONFIDENTIALISED UNIT RECORD FILES**

### **STEPS INVOLVED**

- 1** If you wish to purchase an Australian Bureau of Statistics Confidentialised Unit Record File (CURF) you will be required to fill in the Order Form and the associated undertaking and return them to the Australian Bureau of Statistics. Your order will then be referred to the Australian Statistician for consideration. Under the *Census and Statistics Act 1905*, the Australian Statistician may only release unit record information in accordance with the provisions of a Determination under the Act, and these require that the recipient of such information signs an undertaking which specifies the conditions under which such information is released and the uses to which it may be put.
- 2** Please read the Conditions of sale in Section One before completing the Order Form and the associated undertaking.
- 3** The Order Form allows you to specify your technical specifications for the CURF and a delivery address.
- 4** Individuals or, in the case of organisations, a responsible officer of that organisation, seeking access to a unit record file will be required to sign an appropriate undertaking indicating that they accept the conditions under which the data is provided and the uses to which it may be put.
- 5** The Australian Statistician cannot approve the release of unit record data until signed undertakings have been received from those persons or organisations who are seeking access to the information.

## **SECTION ONE**

### **CONDITIONS OF SALE 1994 NATIONAL ABORIGINAL TORRES STRAIT ISLANDER SURVEY (NATSIS) CONFIDENTIALISED UNIT RECORD FILE (CURF)**

#### **INTERPRETATION**

- 1** 'ABS' means the Australian Bureau of Statistics.
- 2** 'Data' means 1994 National Aboriginal Torres Strait Islander Survey (NATSIS) Confidentialised Unit Record File.
- 3** 'Commercialise', in respect of the Data or a product derived from the Data, means to manufacture, sell, distribute, hire or otherwise exploit a product or process, or to provide a service, incorporating the Data or any product or service derived from the Data, or to license a third party to do any of the above.
- 4** 'Purchaser' means the individual or organisation granted access to the CURF.
- 5** 'Licence Fee' means \$5,500.
- 6** 'Statistical Purposes' means use by the purchaser to produce information of a statistical nature. Examples of such uses are:
  - the manipulation of the Data to produce means, correlations or other descriptive or summary measures;
  - the estimation of population characteristics from the Data;
  - the use of the Data as input to mathematical models and for other types of analyses (e.g. factor analysis); and
  - to provide graphical or pictorial representations of characteristics of the population or sub-sets of the population.

#### **PERMITTED USES**

- 7** The ABS grants the purchaser a non-transferable, non-exclusive licence to use the Data on the terms and conditions set out in the associated undertaking.
- 8** The purchaser is permitted to:
  - use the Data within, and for the purposes of, their organisation only;
  - use the Data for Statistical Purposes only;
  - make a back-up copy of the Data to be labelled with the same copyright notice as the Data and to be used by their organisation only; and
  - produce hard copies and computer files from the Data for use within their organisation.
- 9** The purchaser must treat the Data as private and confidential to the ABS and must take all reasonable measures to protect the Data from unauthorised use, replication, distribution or publication.

USES NOT PERMITTED	<p><b>10</b> The purchaser may not make copies of or use the Data, except as permitted by these Conditions of Sale.</p> <p><b>11</b> The purchaser may not alter, decompile, disassemble or otherwise dispose of the Data.</p> <p><b>12</b> The purchaser may not rent, lease, sub-license, lend, sell, assign or transfer the Data to a third party.</p>
LEGISLATIVE RESTRAINTS	<p><b>13</b> The release of this Data to the purchaser is subject to a Ministerial Determination made under the Census and Statistics Act 1905. BREACHES OF THESE CONDITIONS	<p><b>15</b> In our sole opinion, if the purchaser has failed to comply with any of the Conditions of Sale, the ABS by notice in writing will demand return of all copies of the Data in their possession, power or control. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY	<p><b>19</b> The ABS gives no warranty, other than a warranty that may be implied by law, that the Data is free from errors, is complete, has any particular quality, is suitable for any purpose or otherwise.</p> <p><b>20</b> Subject to any warranty which may be implied by law, our liability to the purchaser for any loss, damage or injury howsoever caused by the ABS, whether due to negligence or otherwise, in relation to the Data shall be limited to providing a replacement copy of the Data.</p> <p><b>21</b> The purchaser agrees to indemnify the ABS (and our servants and agents) in respect of all liability for loss (including all legal costs), or liability from any claim, suit, demand, action or proceeding brought by any third person in connection with this Condition of Sale or from their use of the Data.</p>

A unit record file consisting of unidentified individual statistical records containing Data on 18,753 persons including demographic Data for household, income unit, family and person levels. A full list of the data items are listed in Appendix A in *The Technical Paper: 1994 National Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Survey Unit Record File*.

## **LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY**

Subsection 13(1) of the Census and Statistics Act 1905 ('the Act') provides for the Minister administering the Act to make determinations allowing, with the approval in writing of the Australian Statistician ('the Statistician'), the disclosure of a specified class of information.

On 16 February 1983, the Minister of State for Veterans' Affairs acting for and on behalf of the Treasurer (the latter being the Minister at that time administering the Act) made such a determination ('the Determination'), being No. 19 of the Statutory Rules 1983.

The relevant parts of the Act and the Determination are reproduced below.

### **SUBSECTIONS 13(1) AND (2), CENSUS AND STATISTICS ACT 1905**

**1** Notwithstanding anything in this Act (other than this section), the Minister may, by instrument in writing, make determinations providing for and in relation to the disclosure, with the approval in writing of the Statistician, of information included in a specified class of information furnished in the pursuance of this Act.

**2** Without limiting the generality of subsection (1), determinations may make provision

- a** as to the person to whom the information may be disclosed;
- b** as to the persons, being the persons from whom the information has been obtained, whose consent is required for the disclosure of the information; and
- c** specifying terms and conditions subject to which the information may be disclosed, including, but without limiting the generality of the foregoing, terms and conditions as to the requiring of a person to whom the information is, or is to be, disclosed to give an undertaking, in writing with respect to the disclosure of the information by that person, including an undertaking not to disclose any of the information to any person.

**3** Information of a personal or domestic nature relating to a person shall not be disclosed in accordance with a determination in a manner that is likely to enable the identification of that person.

### **SUBSECTIONS 19(1) AND (2), CENSUS AND STATISTICS ACT 1905**

**1** A person who is, or has been, the Statistician or an officer shall not, except

- a** in accordance with a determination; or
- b** for the purposes of this Act,

either directly or indirectly, divulge or communicate any information furnished in pursuance of this Act to any person (other than the person from whom the information was obtained).

**2** A person who contravenes subsection (1) or fails to comply with an undertaking of the kind referred to in paragraph 13(2)(c) given by him in relation to information disclosed to him in accordance with a determination is guilty of an indictable offence punishable on conviction by a fine not exceeding \$5,000 or imprisonment for a period not exceeding 2 years, or both.

## **CLAUSE 7 OF THE STATISTICS DETERMINATION (STATUTORY RULES 1983, NO. 19)**

**1** Information in the form of individual statistical records may, with the approval in writing of the Statistician, be disclosed where

- a** all identifying information such as name and address has been removed;
- b** the information is disclosed in a manner that is not likely to enable the identification of the particular person or organisation to which it relates; and
- c** the Statistician has been given a relevant undertaking for the purposes of this clause.

**2** A reference in paragraph (1)(c) to a relevant undertaking shall be read as a reference to an undertaking in writing by

- a** in the case of information to be disclosed to a person, being an individual - that person;
- b** in the case of information to be disclosed to an official body - the responsible Minister in relation to, or a responsible officer of, that official body; or
- c** in the case of information to be disclosed to an organisation other than an official body - a responsible officer of that organisation, that use of the information will be subject to the following terms and conditions:
- d** no attempt will be made to identify particular persons or organisations; and
- e** the information will be used only for statistical purposes; and
- f** the information will not be disclosed to any other person or organisation; and
- g** if the Statistician considers it necessary in a particular case - either or both of the following
  - i** that the information, and all copies (if any) of the information, will be returned to the Statistician as soon as the statistical purposes for which it was disclosed have been achieved;
  - ii** that access by officers to information, documents or premises will be given as may be necessary for the purpose of conducting a compliance audit concerning observance of the terms and conditions under which the information is disclosed; and
- h** any other condition that, in the opinion of the Statistician, is reasonably necessary in a particular case.
