



Primary ongoing job, mostly full-time


Reserve Service

Age profile by service in the ADF






State/territory of usual residence



Educational attainment




Highest level of educational attainment by previous ADF service and never served, persons aged 25-64



Non-school qualifications




Obtained a bachelor degree or higher by previous ADF service and never served and sex, persons aged 25 - 64 years

Non-school qualification by previously served vs never served in the ADF, persons aged 25-64





Labour force status




Labour Force status, by ADF service, persons aged 15-64

Occupation by previously served and never served in the ADF, persons aged 15-64





Long-term health conditions




Long-term health condition by type of service, persons aged 15 years and over



Need for assistance with core activities




Needs assistance by type of previous service and age group, persons aged 15 years and over
